Fast patrol vessel built for Indian coast guard launched

KOLKATA, DEC 30 /-- The First of the series of five Fast Patrol Vessels (FPVs) ships being built for the Indian Coast Guard by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers Limited (GRSE), was launched at the Raja Bagan Dockyard Unit of GRSE, Kolkata, today. Following maritime traditions, the ship was launched by Kadambari Saxena, wife of former union minister VK Saxena, IN (Retd), chairman and managing director (GRSE). Rear admiral AK Verma (Retd), former chairman and man-

aging director, GRSE, chief guest of the event, expressed his pride that most of the ships delivered to Indian Navy in the past year were built by GRSE. Verma congratulated GRSE for getting the coveted contract of five FPVs for the Coast Guard and he urged the engineers and workers to deliver the vessels on time. The entire design of these FPVs has been developed by GRSE as per requirements specified by Indian Coast Guard. The ship is 50M long, 7.5M wide with a displacement of around 308 Tons. The ship is designed for a maximum speed of 34 knots with an endurance of more than 1500 nautical miles. It is equipped with three Main Engines with advanced control systems, Waterjet units and an 'Integrated Bridge System' integrating all communication and navigation systems. These ships are also fitted with 40/60 Gun as main armament and will also have improved habitability features with fully air conditioned modular accommodation for 35 personnel. (EOIC)

Odisha police to go digital from New Year

BHUBANESWAR, DEC 30 /-- The Odisha police is all set to go digital from January 1, 2018 with computerisation of police station work under the Criminal Tracking and New System (CTNS) project, said out of 612 police stations across the state, 589 police stations have been equipped with the necessary hardware and software for successful implementation of the project. Nearly six to seven manual registers at police station levels will be abolished from January 1, 2018 and all the records will be maintained online to avoid duplication of works, Sharma said. Sharma also said that CTNS is like core banking, Sharma said all police stations will have to work online while registering cases, station diaries, case diaries and charge

She said the investigating officers will also be able to use laptops, tabs and smart phones for accessing the database and generating reports easily. Sharma also said maintenance of manual registers, including entry of station diaries, will also go online in various police stations across the state from January 2018.

According to the DGP, 13 citizen centric services are being provided through the Odisha Police Citizens Portal at present, and a mobile application will be launched very soon. "Through the use of technology, we hope that working of police stations will become more transparent and efficient," Sharma said. (PTI)

Four killed, six hurt

JAJPUR, DEC 30 /-- At least four persons were killed and six others critically injured when a van carrying them collided with a truck in Jajpur district today, police said. The mishap took place when the van, carrying passengers to Kainiganagar industrial area, collided with the truck near Baunsoda on National Highway No 200, inspector in-charge of Jajpur police station, SK Das said. While three persons died at the spot, another succumbed to injuries on the way to hospital, he said. The injured persons were first taken to nearby hospital and then shifted to Cuttack for treatment as their condition was critical, police said. (PTI)

Bank heist

GOPALGANJ, DEC 30 /-- Armed miscreants looted around Rs 12 lakh from a bank in Bihar's Gopalganj district today, police said. Station House Officer (SHO) of Kuchaikot police station, Awadhesh Kumar said eight armed miscreants barged into Sasumaa bazar branch of Punjab National Bank and looted around Rs 12 lakh kept in bank's chest at gun point and decamped with the money. As per the Prima facie evidences it seems that miscreants have looted around Rs 12 lakh from bank's chest but the exact amount of loot could be known only after the proper counting of currency is completed, he said. On the basis of CCTV footage, police have identified the involvement of three persons in the loincident and efforts are on to nab them, police sources said. (PTI)

Dense fog bits operations at Patna airport

NEW DELHI, DEC 30 /-- Flight operations at the Patna airport were affected on Friday as dense fog engulfed the aerodrome and visibility dropped below the required limit. As many as four flights have been held up since evening, a source said on Friday night. Of the four flights, three are of IndiGo and one of Air India, he said. "Four flights are awaiting ATC clearance at the Patna airport for departure to various destinations due to dense fog which has enveloped the operations area," the source told PTI over phone from Patna. He said that over 700 passengers are stranded due to the delay in flight operations. Patna airport officials were not available for comments. "Of the four flights whose passengers are stranded, two are parked in the apron area while one each on the runway and taxiway," he said. (PTI)

Damaged demonitised notes found

JAMSHEDPUR, DEC 30 /-- Three sacks full of badly damaged demonitised currency notes were found abandoned beside a canal at Chowka area of Serakela-Kharwan district, a senior police officer said on Friday. "We have recovered three sacks full of demonitised currency notes from a place under Chowka police station last night," said superintendent of police, Chandan Kumar Sinha. The sacks were presumably dumped in the canal long ago and the condition of the notes was so bad that it was impossible to count them, Sinha said. (PTI)

KOLKATA, DEC 30 /-- The West Bengal Left Front on Friday announced the names of candidates for the upcoming by-polls for Uluberia Lok Sabha constituency and Noapara Assembly seat. The Front nominated Sabiruddin Mollah of CPM for Uluberia. Mollah had unsuccessfully contested from the Uluberia Lok Sabha seat in 2014. TMC MP from Uluberia Sultan Ahmed's death earlier this year has necessitated the election. In Noapara Assembly constituency, Left Front nominated Ganesh Chatterjee. The seat fell vacant following the death of Congress MLA Madhusudan Ghose a few months ago. The by-polls would be held on January 29 and counting of votes will take place on February 1. (PTI)

BSF told to keep close vigil on Bangla border: Tripura CEO

AGARTALA, DEC-30 /-- The BSF has been told to keep a close vigil on the 856-km long Indo-Bangla border in Tripura, to prevent entry of unwanted elements into the state, where Assembly elections are due early next year, an election official said. Tripura Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Sriram Taranikant held a meeting with top Border Security Force (BSF) officials regarding the close vigil on the border. "A meeting was held with Inspector General (IG) of BSF, couple of days back. All polling stations along the border were mapped in a special Positioning System (GPS). I hope close vigil will begin in the coming weeks," Taranikant told reporters here last evening. (PTI)
