

# NE insurgency likely to increase after Doklam: Ex-Army officer

**KOLKATA, JAN 29 /-** NE insurgency is likely to increase in the North East (NE) after the Doklam stand-off with China and there are already signs of it in the region. Former GOI-in-C East-ern Command Lt Gen J R Mukherjee said here today.

Whenever India has annoyed China or there has been a border related issue between the two countries, it (China) has aided insurgents in the NE, Mukherjee told newsmen here commenting on the possible fall-out of the 74-day stand-off with the Chinese at Doklam in the

Sikkim sector. "Consequent to Doklam, insurgency will increase in the NE and signs of these are already evident," the retired Lt General, who is the vice-president (operations) of strategic think tank CENERS-K, said.

Mukherjee said that Doklam is neither the first time nor the last that China has made such an attempt. Its army will keep coming and camp at places of that country's strategic interest.

"In Doklam, the China will eventually try to twist the Bhutanese state to get what they want," he said and claimed that the Chinese have not left Doklam but have only stepped back a little. Centre for East and North-East Regional Studies (CENERS), Kolkata, which has as its patron former Army chief Gen Shankar Roy Chowdhury and advisor former air chief marshal Arup Raha, is organising a two-day dialogue on Indo-China issues and relations between the two Asian giants.

The seminar, to be held on February 2 and February 3, is scheduled to be attended by ministers of state for external affairs gen (retd) V K Singh and will delve on issues ranging from political, economic, military capabilities to problems and prospecting to bilateral investments.

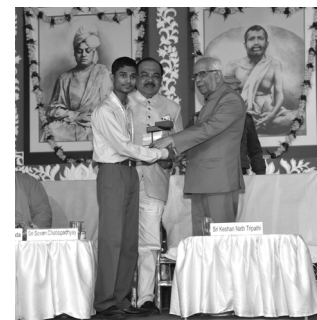

## Former Chhattisgarh, Tripura Gov D N Sahay passes away

**PATNA, JAN 29 /-** Former governor of Chhattisgarh and Tripura Devesh Nandan Sahay died here after prolonged illness, family sources said today. He was 92. He is survived by a son and two daughters. He breathed his last at a private hospital late last night, the sources said. Born in 1936, Sahay began his career with the Indian Police Service and rose to the position of the DGP of Bihar. After retirement, he had joined the Samata Party and became the first Governor of Chhattisgarh after the state was carved out of Madhya Pradesh in 2000. In 2003, Sahay took over as the Governor of Tripura and held the post till 2009. Condoling the death, Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar described Sahay as "an efficient political figure and police officer and a dedicated social worker". Kumar also visited Sahay's residence here and consoled the bereaved family members. (PTI)

## Preparation on for repatriation of Brus from Mizoram

**AIZAWL, JAN 29 /-** Mizoram government has started preparation to repatriate over 32,000 Bru people from six relief camps in neighbouring Tripura from the first week of March, additional secretary to state home department Labbaikzama today said. The Centre has released Rs 9 crore as first instalment for the repatriation expenditure, while the state government estimated that over Rs 123 crore would be required for the purpose, he said.

"Physical repatriation can only begin after the identification of those who wanted to be repatriated," Labbaikzama told PTI. An inspection team comprising officials of the Ministry of home affairs and the Mizoram government would visit the relief camps in February to identify the Brus who are willing to return to Mizoram and those who are not. Thousands of Brus of Mizoram fled to North Tripura district due to communal tension triggered by the murder of a forest official by Bru militants on October 21, 1997. Since then, many of them returned to Mizoram during repatriation processes or on their own. (PTI)

## 11 political parties in Nagaland not to contest Assembly polls

**KOHHIMA, JAN 29 /-** In a major development poll-bound Nagaland, 11 parties including the ruling Naga Peoples Front today decided not to contest the February 27 elections, agreeing to the demand of tribal bodies and civil society groups to resolve the protracted Naga political problem first. The decision came at a meeting called by the core committee of Nagaland Tribal Hoos and Civil Organisations (CNTHO) and attended by representatives of 11 parties. "It is the unanimous view of the

Naga people that a political solution or Naga peace accord is more important than elections and therefore, it has become imperative that the elections to the legislative Assembly of Nagaland be deferred for peace and tranquillity," read a joint declaration signed by the parties.
