

Impasse ends, TV serial shooting to resume tomorrow

KOLKATA, AUG 23—/The deadlock between artists and producers of TV serials over regularisation of payment ended today, with Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee giving an assurance that a committee formed with representatives from both sides will "look into the issues". Shooting for the mega soapwishes resumed tomorrow, she said. A conciliation committee, with state Youth Affairs Minister Aroop Biswas as the chairman and veteran actor Saumitra Chatterjee as chief adviser, has been constituted to look into the problems of both sides," she said. The impasse had stalled shooting of serials for six days, forcing TV channels to repeat episodes.

Mamata, who holds meetings this afternoon with representatives of Artists' Forum and Welfare Association of Television Producers, also asserted that payments would be made by 15th of every month. Chatterjee and superstar Prasennjit Chatterjee were among others who represented the Artists' Forum at the meeting today. "Full-fledged shootings will resume from tomorrow morning. Thankfully, the problem has not aggravated much and we are happy that everything has been resolved," the CM said. Stressing that thousands of people earn their livelihood from television and film industries, Mamata said the conciliation committee would hold meetings every month with the artists and technicians. "The committee will look into the complaints in this (TV) industry. They will see if the artists, technicians or producers have been deprived of their rights," the chief minister said. The Artists' Forum had demanded salaries by 15th of every month and hourly payments if the shooting schedule exceeded 10 hours. "We must not forget the employment opportunity in this industry. This is a very potential and popular industry. People watch entertainment from television and news channels...I'm also an avid viewer," she said. Saumitra Chatterjee, too, expressed satisfaction with the outcome of today's meeting at the secretariat building. "We are happy that the impasse has been resolved with the intervention of the chief minister. We thank her," he said. Others who were also on the committee include Arindam Ganguly, Nispal Singh Rana, Saibal Banerjee, Sri Kanta Mohata, Swarup Biswas, Aparna Ghatak, Leena Gangopadhyay, all from the artists and producers, Channel Star Jalsha representative Sagnik Bose, Zee representative Samrat Ghosh, Colors Bangla representative Rahul Chakravarty.

Police offer mobile phones to tribal leaders for faster communication through WhatsApp

MALDA, 23 AUG—/Bringing the tribal community closer state government is now taking help of social communication media. As a part of the outreach programme leaders of tribal community were gifted with free mobile-phones by the superintendent of police Arbab Ghosh today. Chunarim Murmu, a tribal leader said that the policy would be helpful for communicating different schemes of state government to community members. 50 leaders of the community would use the mobile phones for linking the community members with the government. "We have been told that different schemes launched by state government and ways to avail benefit from those would be communicated to us through the mobile. At the same time we would be passing the feedback of our community to the officials of the administration," Murmu added. It has been learnt from the officials that the tribal leaders would generate WhatsApp groups where common members of the community would be benefited. Different issues and suggestions delivered at the groups would be discussed and addressed, if necessary. Along with Ghosh, officials of district civil and police administrations were present at the programme. "The mobile phones would act like a bridge between us and the tribal community. We believe the issues concerned with tribal community would draw attention easily when delivered and discussed in WhatsApp groups," Ghosh said.

Take steps to fight seasonal diseases, WB govt tells officials

KOLKATA, AUG 23—/The West Bengal government today directed district magistrates and other officials to take precautionary measures to fight the possible outbreak of dengue and other seasonal diseases. The decision was taken at an administrative review meeting held here at the state secretariat in the presence of Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee. "A detailed discussion was held today. Stress has been given on the cleanliness in the panchayat and urban areas," Banerjee said. The district magistrates were asked to monitor the condition of the rivers and dams during the ongoing monsoon season, she said. "Irrigation secretary gives his feedback every week. We are deliberating whether audit maps of dams can be prepared," the CM said. The district magistrates and the BDOs have also been asked to look into the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) scheme and the mid-day meal scheme, she said.

Asthi Kalash of former PM on way to Gangasagar

KOLKATA, AUG 23—/ Amidst slogans of 'Ataaji Zindabad', the West Bengal BJP unit today took out the 'Asthi Kalash Yatra' with the ashes of former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. Union minister Smriti Irani, who was here to join the rally and offer floral tributes, said she was overwhelmed at the turnout of people, mostly women, along the roads, to pay respects to the former prime minister. State BJP president Dilip Ghosh and other state leaders of the party took out the rally which covered various parts of central and south Kolkata as it headed towards Gangasagar, where the ashes will be immersed. The procession is likely to reach Gangasagar by this evening, a party

leader said. The 'asthi kalash' was brought to Kolkata by the state BJP president yesterday evening. Gangasagar is an island off the coast of Bengal where the Ganga river meets the Bay of Bengal. A part of the content from the main kalash (urn) has been distributed in four other urns. The main urn will be immersed at Gangasagar and the four others will be taken to north Bengal, Farakka, Bankura and Nabadwip. Jaiprakash Majumdar, vice-president of West Bengal BJP unit told PTI. One killed, two injured in explosion at TMC office

MIDNAPORE, AUG 23—/ One person was killed and two others were seriously injured in an explosion at a Trinamool Congress office at Makrampur in the district, official sources here said. The identity of the deceased and the injured was not immediately known, they said. The explosion took place around 10 am. The injured were admitted to a hospital and the police have cordoned off the area. The sources said it was also not known whether a crude bomb had exploded or a gas cylinder inside the party office led to the incident. Pradyumn Ghosh, TMC MLA of Narayangarh, said that the cause of the explosion could not be ascertained till noon and the police were looking into it.

Electricity official punishes load shedding sufferers with confinement

MALDA, 23 AUG: Excitement greeted Chanchal after a senior official of state electricity distribution company limited (SEDLCL) today confirmed as many as 20 persons who were confined to their homes after being released from confinement said that they were under load voltage and frequent power cut at different villages in Harischandrapur. The village was freed after a media-personnel reached the spot. Aggrieved villagers later demonstrated in front of the office and lodged a police complaint against Anirban Adak, divisional manager of SEDCL, Malda north division. Azizur Rahaman, Mohammed Umar Farooque and others who were released from confinement said that they went to SEDCL division office in Chanchal to complain about the poor power supply to Talgaohi, Alakantaj, Kartaria and other villages in Harischandrapur. "We raised the issue before as well. It was further suggested that instead of the feeder point located at a distance of 30 km, power supply to those villages should be made from a closer feeder point located only 6 km away. The concerned official assured to consider our proposal and asked us to meet him at the office," Alam said. "While we were discussing problems with the divisional manager, he suddenly turned furious. To our dismay the divisional manager directed the security to keep us under lock & key. We were released only when the media personnel came," Rahaman said. Congress MLA of Harischandrapur Mostaque Alam said that he would communicate the incident to state power minister and the Chief Minister demanding punishment of the concerned officer. Sub divisional police officer Sajid Biswas said that police were looking into the matter. Adak, however, was not available for comment. "I'm busy right now and can't talk," he said.
