

Outsiders harming interests of CU students: Partha

KOLKATA, JAN 30 --/ West Bengal education minister Partha Chatterjee has expressed concern over the dip in pass percentage in Part-I results of the Calcutta University and said outsiders were vitiating the atmosphere in the institutes. He said he is harming the interests of the students.

A group of students, with affiliations to different students' unions, were seen protesting over the poor show in Part-I results on the university campus on Monday. The minister said it was

not proper for a student to fail and then demonstrate on the campus.

"We have seen outsiders coming to the campus to demonstrate on the issues. We are keeping watch on this. This only harms the future of students," he said here on Monday. Chatterjee was talking to the media after a meeting with Calcutta University pro vice-chancellor Dipak Kar and other senior CU officials in the wake of the poor performance by the BA and BSc Part I (honours and general) students. To a question about

what transpired in the talks, the minister said, "I had heard their views. But I haven't made any recommendations."

To another question about some undergraduate colleges attributing change in exam assessment rules for the poor show, Chatterjee said, "Let the colleges approach the university if they wish so. If the government intervenes they will say their autonomy was not being safeguarded." The pro-V-C said he has apprised the minister of the develop-

ments on the campus.

"He has asked us not to compromise on the issue of academic excellence. We will think about steps that need to be taken to resolve the issue at the next syndicate meeting." Of the 64,000 candidates that appeared for the BA Part I (Honours and general stream) exam, just 28,000 have passed, the results published last Thursday revealed. In the BSc stream, around 11,000 students of the total 15,000 that sat for the exam made it. (PTI)

RJD leaders' presence in Union minister's function sparks speculation

PATNA, JAN 30 --/ Senior RJD leaders Shivnand Tiwari and Ramchandra Purje today joined a human chain formed by the Union minister Uppendra Kushwaha, triggering speculations about the need for improvement in public education and the people's right to demand it under the Right to Education Act.

Acting Bihar Congress president Kaulab Qadri said despite the BJP-led alliance heartedly supporting the human chain event on January 21 organised by the Nitish Kumar ministry against downy and child marriage, the "cold" response of the JD-U and BJP to the one held by him was a "strong" message to the RJD leader to rethink his continuance in the NDA. "Today's incident was not a fluke. It vindicates RJD vice-president Raghuvansh Prasad Singh's claim that Kushwaha is un-der the BJP-led alliance across the state in public education and the people's right to demand it under the Right to Education Act."

Qadri told PTI. However,

Kushwaha and the two RJD leaders insisted that no political meaning should be attached to today's demonstration.

At a press conference held immediately after the event, Kushwaha said, "We had planned to hold human chain on this day for 30 minutes at one school in every panchayat across the state. The response has been more than we had expected. Sincere thanks to Tiwari and Purje for coming out in our support". Asked to comment on the absence of JD-U and BJP leaders, the RJD chief claimed, "All NDA constituencies have supported our endeavour. Senior leaders of some parties may not have taken part because of other engagements but ground level workers have contributed in making our event a success".

Tiwari told reporters separately that the RJD leader

ers joined the event to support the cause Kushwaha was pursuing.

"Public education system in Bihar is in doldrums and Nitish Kumar ministry has been too busy with its gimmicks on child marriage and dowry to pay attention to these essential matters of governance". BJP state vice-president Mrityunjay Tiwari came down heavily on the party's stance. "The RJD is in the NDA while pretending to support education reforms in the state. He said education was destroyed when RJD ruled Bihar. Kushwaha is in the NDA and will remain in the alliance."

We are of the view that if he had any concerns regarding education scenario in the state, he should have coordinated with the governments at the Centre and the state since NDA is in power in both places. As far as BJP's non-participation is concerned, I am not sure whether his party had approached for supporting the event," he said. JD-U spokesman Ajay Alok said Kushwaha's cause enjoys the party's moral support. "But the JD-U could not have actively participated in any move which enjoys RJD's backing".

"It is our duty to immunize our children, especially girls, from deadly diseases so that our future generation grows up hale and hearty. I appeal to my fellow citizens to lend their cent percent support to the campaign," he said, adding that the programme aims to vaccinate five lakh children. (PTI)

All petrol pumps in Bihar to have PUC centres by March

The department had, on January 25, 2018, issued a directive to all the district magistrates and transport officers for compliance of its order by the end of the current financial year - March, 2018. "All petrol pumps will have PUC centres across the state in view of the Supreme court's order and subsequent advisory issued by the Central government to all the states in this regard," transport department secretary Sanjay Kumar Aggarwal told PTI. There are 2,550 petrol pumps belonging to three oil marketing companies in Bihar as on January 1, 2018, said Veena Kumari, chief manager, Planning and Coordination, IOCI, Patna.
