

# State Cong to bring no-confidence motion against TMC in Assembly

**KOLKATA, NOV 30 /- /** West Bengal Pradesh Congress Committee has decided to bring a no-confidence motion against the Trinamool (TMC) government in West Bengal in the upcoming Assembly session starting from December 2.

The party, whose number of legislators have come down to 39 after five MLAs

switched over to TMC, said it will get in touch with the Left Front, which has 31 MLAs, to enlist its support for the motion. TMC had won 21 seats out of 294 in the Assembly election, defeating the Left-Congress combine.

"We have decided to bring no-confidence motion against the corrupt government. The way it has

poached on our MLAs, elected representatives in rural bodies and municipalities is not only undemocratic, but also unprecedented in the history of Bengal politics," Leader of Opposition and state Congress leader Abdul Mannan said. # Over 82 per cent domestic violence victims in Bihar not satisfied with redress services: Study

**NEW DELHI/PATNA, NOV 30 /- /** Over 82 per cent victims of domestic violence in Bihar remain dissatisfied with redress services provided by relevant institutions such as helplines, police stations, NGOs in the state, a study has found.

The study conducted by CARE India in partnership with Mahila Jagran Kendra (MJK) and released here today also reveals only 67 per cent protection officers and 42 per cent police stations in Bihar register complaints.

The study covered both rural and urban areas from nine districts of nine commissioners in Bihar and the survivors were randomly selected from different socio-economic backgrounds. The study report highlighted the gap and quality of services being rendered by state-facilitated support institutions and stakeholders and the experience of the survivors in accessing justice under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence (PWDV) Act.

All survivors who were interviewed said lack of knowledge about various provision of the Act made them run from one institu-

## SER to run more superfast specials between Santragachi and Puri

**KOLKATA, NOV 30 /- /** To clear extra rush of passengers during the winter season for popular tourist destination, it has been decided by the South Eastern Railway authority to run eight pairs of Superfast Specials between Santragachi and Puri from December 8 and January 27, 2017. The Special Train (02809) leaving Santragachi every Thursday at 7 pm will reach Puri at 3.20 am the next day. In the op-

posite direction, the Special Train (02810) will leave Puri every Friday at 1.30 pm arriving Santragachi at 10.15 pm the same day. The Special trains will have one AC-2 Tier, four AC 3 Tier and twelve Sleeper Class coaches. The train will have stoppages at Kharagpur, Balasore, Bhadrak, Jajpur-Keonjhar Road, Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Khurda Road between Santragachi and Puri. (EOIC)
