Agromet advisory bulletin

PORT BLAIR, OCT 31 -- The Central Island Agricultural Research Institute has released the agromet bulletin for farmers for the period from November 1 to 5. In the bulletin, CIARI forecast cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall in the next five days. In South Andaman 61 mm of rainfall, in North and Middle Andaman 48 mm of rainfall and in Nicobar Island 138 mm of heavy rainfall is expected during this period. The maximum temperature will be 30 to 32 degree centigrade with minimum temperature of 24 to 26 degree centigrade, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 72 to 83 % and 58 to 76%, respectively in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speed of 12 to 55 kph is expected from North Easterly direction.

Farmers in South Andaman have been advised to harvest the mature paddy and keep open the bunds to drain rain water as good amount of rainfall is expected, harvest mature vegetables and sent to the market to avoid losses due to rain, stock the fry (2-5 cm) @ 2-3 lakh/ha and remove wild fishes manually during sampling and give vaccine against foot and mouth disease for pig as the condition is favorable for its spread. In Nicobar, farmers have been advised to avoid application of manure to the vegetable field as moderate to heavy rainfall is expected during next five days and to give vaccine against foot and mouth disease for pig as the condition is favorable for its spread.

The requests include opening of Red Skin and Jolly Buoy on all days (including Mondays) as the rush to visit these islands by tourists has grown manifold in recent times, increase of boats plying to and fro from these islands to be increased to cope with the demand, identity cards of all visiting tourists most of the time cannot be downloaded with clarity due to the low internet speed here and are rejected at embarking point at Wandoor, which has become a recurring problem distressing tourists who have travelled so far as our guests. Therefore, it is requested to introduce previous system of asking for the ID card of one member of a family for forest permits, and thereof all members can present their original cards to forest staff at Wandoor at the time of embarkation.
