UP to implement 'Sujalam Sufalam' campaign in two districts of Bundelkhand

LUCKNOW, OCT 7—Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath instructed officials on Sunday to study and implement Maharashtra's 'Sujalam Sufalam' campaign in two districts of Bundelkhand region which is facing a drought-like situation. According to a statement issued by the office of the UP chief minister, Adityanath lauded the campaign while watching a presentation on it at his official residence here and said that a team under the agriculture production commissioner should study it so that it could be implemented as a pilot project in Mahoba and Hamirpur. "After seeing the results of the campaign in both the districts, it will be implemented in Bundelkhand, so that water could be made

available in the villages. Water harvesting-related work in future should be done as per this campaign," the chief minister said in the statement. Under the 'Sujalam Sufalam' campaign, dams, ponds, minor irrigation tanks, percolation ponds and farm ponds are first identified, and then, digging work is carried out to deepen them. The silt from the dams and water bodies is cleaned, the drains are widened and deepened (if necessary). Adityanath said the UP government was working on various schemes to address the problem of drinking water in Bundelkhand. He added that dependency on the Ganga and the Yamuna rivers for water has to be reduced. (PTI)

India not adequately harnessing potential of women in science: Prez

LUCKNOW, OCT 7—President Ram Nath Kovind on Saturday expressed concern over the low participation of women in higher education, saying the country is not adequately harnessing their scientific potential and it is a collective responsibility to overcome this social and systemic challenge.

He noted that of the 3,446 scientists working at the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, a premier national research and development organisation, only 632 or 18.3 per cent are women. "In a week when women scientists have won Nobel prizes for physics and for chemistry, this is a telling statistic. It is a reminder of the scientific potential of women that we are not adequately harnessing. This is both a social and systemic challenge but it is our collective responsibility to overcome it," the President said.

Two shot dead in Sikar: Police

SIKAR, OCT 7—A police inspector and a constable, who were chasing an SUV that had sped past a barricade, were allegedly shot dead near Beswa village under Fatehpur police station in this district, officials said Sunday. Sikar Superintendent of Police Pradeep Mohan Sharma said Fatehpur police station in-charge Mukesh Kanungo and Constable Prakash were shot dead when they were chasing the miscreants.

The two policemen were on routine duty at the check post on Saturday night, when one Ajay Chaudhary and four of his associates approached the barricade in a sports utility vehicle, Sharma said. The policemen signalled the SUV to stop. The vehicle slowed down momentarily and then sped past the check post, prompting the policemen to give them a chase, he added. At this, the SUV occupants opened fire at the police vehicle, killing the inspector and the constable, the Sikar SP said. (PTI)

Crores exchanged hands in appointment of VCs: TN Gov

CHENNAI, OCT 7—Tamil Nadu Governor Banwarilal Purohit has alleged that crores of rupees exchanged hands in the appointment of vice-chancellors to universities before he took over. Reacting to his remarks, the ruling All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) in the state said it had no role in the appointments of vice-chancellors. The Tamil Makkal Katchi (PMK) had in February demanded a probe by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) into alleged corruption in the universities of Tamil Nadu. Higher Education Minister K P Anbazhagan said, "I am duty bound to clarify that the government has no role in the appointment of

vice-chancellors." He dubbed Purohit's remarks as "surprising" since the minister said that the governor to appoint vice-chancellors were made by search committees, over which the government had no control. The government member appointed only one member — an eminent educationist of standing or a government secretary — to the search committees to recommend the names of vice-chancellors, while the two other members were named by the university syndicate and the governor respectively, the minister said. The government does not even see or ask who were recommended for the top posts by the committee, he said, adding that only the governor selected the

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Arun Jaitley to spend his MP area development funds on Rae Bareilly: UP BJP spokesperson

LUCKNOW, OCT 7—Union Finance Minister Arun Jaitley will spend his MP area development funds on Rae Bareilly, a move being seen as an attempt by the BJP to breach the Gandhi family bastion in the 2019 Lok Sabha polls. "Representative" of Arun Jaitley as UP BJP spokesperson Hero Bajpai told PTI, "Almost a month back, Jaitley had chosen Rae Bareilly district as a Rajya Sabha MP from Uttar Pradesh. The backwardness of the district despite being represented by a prominent political family and the various demands in which it has emanating from the district, prompted Jaitley ji to choose this."

Under the Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS), each MP has the choice to suggest to the district collector for works to the tune of Rs 5 crore per annum to be taken up in his/her constituency. A Rajya Sabha MP can

recommend works in one or more districts in the state from where he/she has been elected.

"The Union finance minister may tour Rae Bareilly in the first or second week of November," However, Bajpai ruled out any possibility of an edited version of the Lok Sabha elections between Sonia Gandhi and Arun Jaitley. "He (Jaitley) will not contest the Lok Sabha in 2019, but will strengthen the BJP in the Congress bastion," Jaitley's representative said.

"The people in Rae Bareilly have been demanding a stadium, a university, solar lights and solar energy-operated pumps in remote villages of the district," Bajpai said, and added that the government made to fulfil all the incomplete works in the district so that people could have a sigh of relief. He also said Rs 2.5 crore had already reached the chief development officer of Rae Bareilly (the nodal person to carry

out the works using the MPLADS funds). Rae Bareilly is currently represented by Sonia Gandhi in the Lok Sabha, while the neighbouring parliamentary constituency of Amethi is represented by Rahul Gandhi (current Congress president).

Prior to this, Indira Gandhi had won from Rae Bareilly in 1980, while her elder son Rajiv Gandhi had represented Amethi in Lok Sabha in 1984, 1990 and 1991. Sanjay Gandhi had won from Amethi in 1980.

"Rae Bareilly, which remained in darkness, as development eluded it during the Congress rule, has now started experiencing the first rays of development touching its soil. Whenever any stalwart leader enters the district, it adds a new dimension to the growth saga of the district," Bajpai said, claiming that people of Rae Bareilly are happy that the Union minister will be spending his MP area development funds on the district.

Ganapathy was arrested by the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption (DVA) officers, claiming that he was involved in the following which he was suspended.

Woman raped by three men

MUZAFFAR NAGAR (UP), OCT 7—A 24-year-old woman was allegedly raped by three men in Budhana town in this district of Uttar Pradesh, police said Sunday.

The incident took place Saturday when the woman, who was waiting for a bus to return to her village, was gived in a three-wheeled auto, who took her to a forest area and raped her. Station House Officer (SHO), Budhana, Sai Bhagwan said. On the basis of a complaint from the woman, a case was registered against the three accused who were absconding, he said, adding that the victim was sent for a medical examination.

According to the complaint lodged by the victim, she was taken to Budhana from her village, Phugana, and was pulled by the three men on her motorcycle on her way back. (PTI)

Shah also accused former prime minister Manmohan Singh of not uttering a word while infiltrators sneaked into the country and behaved in Indian soldiers. "After the BJP came to power, they (terrorists from Pakistan) made the mistake of attacking our jawans at Uri at 3 AM and did not give a chance to retaliate. Twelve soldiers were killed," he said. "On the tenth day (of the attack), Modi ordered our soldiers to retaliate. Our brave jawans conducted a surgical strike and took revenge," the BJP chief said. Earlier only the US and Israel were known for avenging the death of their soldiers, now India's name has been added to this list, he said. (PTI)
