#### Top BJP leaders meet, discuss Ayodhya verdict

NEW DELIH, APRIL 19 /--/ Top B-IP leaders today discussed the political and legal fallout of the Supreme Court eventiet on the Babri mosqia demosition that thus come as a setback to the party's sidelined veterans including I. K Advain Prime Minister Narendra Modi. BIP president Amit Shah, union ministers Arun Jaitley, Rajnath Singh, Nitin Gadkari and M Venkaiah Naidu were huddled for two hours at Modi's residence. But a senior party leader played down the meeting's significance, saying it had a number of issues, including the Kashmir crisis, on its agenda. The meeting was held against the backdrop of the apex court verdict allowing the CBI top ut Advani, 89, Murli Manohar Joshi, 83, and Uma Bharti, 57, on trial after restoring the criminal conspiracy charges against them.

A senior leader insisted that it was a pre-scheduled meeting. It is understood that the apex court verdict and its implications - political as well as legal - were also discussed with the leadership exploring various options to deal with it. Bharti, who had earlier in the days aid she would go to Ayodhya tonight, cancelled her visit apparently after being advised by the party leadership. Some BJP leaders said the party would not like the message to go out that the 'heroes' of its most resonant Hindutva movement, spearheaded by Advani in early 90s, were tried for criminal conspiracy when it was in power at the Centre as well in Uttar Pradesh. For the record, senior leader and Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad said the party will study in detail the court verdict before offering comments.

Prasad asserted that BJP highly respects its leaders like Advani and Joshi. The party has held the position that the demolition of mosque was not planned but a spontaneous act of agitating 'kar sevaks' and there was no conspiracy behind its razing on December 6, 1992 at the disputed site in Ayodhya. The uneasy relationship that Modi and Shah share with Advani and Joshi also does not help the party. ## EC gets funds for paper trail machines

NEW DELHI, APRIL 19 /-/ The Election Commission's plan to go for paper trail machines in the next Lok Sabba polls to add an additional layer of transparency in voting is set to materialise as the government today cleared Rs 3.174 corre for the purpose. A total of 16.15,000 Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) machines would be purchased to cover all polling stations. Several parties have been pressing for the use of these machines to dispel doubts that the EVMs are not tampered with. Sixteen parties had recently petitioned the EC to revert to paper ballot system for greater transparency The BSP, the AAP and the Congress had attacked the EC on the issue of alleged tampering of EVMs. The paper trail machines leave a paper trail which helps an elector confirm whether the EVM has faithfully registered the vote has has cast to a particular candi-

The Supreme Court has asked the Commission to give a Court has asked the Commission to give a tentative timeframe by which it can use VVPAT machines in all polling stations. The EC says two PSUs - ECIL and BEL - need 30 months to produce the over 16 lakh VVPATs. The VVPAT is a machine which dismosase clip with the carebol of IAKN VPATS. The VVPAT is a machine which dispenses a slip with the symbol of the party for which a person has voted for. The slip drops in a box but the voter cannot take it home. The voters see voter-verifiable paper audit trial slip for seven seconds, which would be an acknowledgement receipt for the party they voted for in the election. According to an official

statement, 16,15,000 VVPAT units - at a tentative cost of Rs 19,650 per machine -- will come for Rs 3173.47 crore (excluding taxes and freight as applicable). The idea of an additional layer of transparency for the satisfaction of voters in the form of VVPAT was suggested by the political parties in October, 2010. Accordingly, introduction of the VVPAT was facilitated by amending the Conduct of Election Rules in August, 2013. Thereafter, 20,300 VVPAT units were purchased by the EC in 2013. Since then, these units are being deployed in elections in select assembly and parliamentary constituencies. Subsequently, order for 67,000 additional units was placed in 2015, out of which 33,500 have been supplied. The Cabinet has so far cleared two tranches or 81,000 crore and Rs 9,200 respectively for the Commission to buy new electronic voting machines.(PTI)

The revelation comes against the backdrop of demands from aspiring teachers and education stakeholders for filling up vacant positions in various institutions including the prestigious IITs and central universities such as the DU. According to the annual report for the year 2015-16, submitted by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, which manages operations of the KVs across the country, out of total 1,081 posts for principals; 200 of them are vacant while position of Vice-Principals is vacant in 113 schools. -/ Union minister and BJP leader Uma Bharti today dis-missed the Congress de-mand for her resignation af-ter the Supreme Court or-dered that she be tried for criminal conspiracy in the 1992 Babri Masjid demoli-tion case. There was "no con-spiracy and everything was spiracy and everything was in open" in the matter, she told reporters after the apex court verdict. Bharti said she was "proud, unapolo-getic and unrepentant" for being associated with the Ram Janmabhoomi movement and was prepared to get "hanged or be jailed" on the issue of contruction of a Ram temple at the disputed

site in Ayodhya. The fire-brand leader said she will leave for Ayodhya tonight to seek Lord Ram's blessings for the construction of a temple. No one can stop its construction, she stressed. "There was no conspiracy, everything was in the open...I was associated with the Ram temple movement with full confidence and pride. "The court has said that we be tried for con-spiracy. There was no conspiracy... Yes, I was present in Ayodhya on De-cember 6, 1992 (when the cemper 6, 1992 (when the disputed structure was de-molished). Where does one see any conspiracy?" Bharti asked."I am ready to face

whatever punishment it takes for contruction of a temple at Ayodhya or be it on issue of cleaning of the Ganga, the tricolour or the cow. I have never repented or apologised," she said. Hit ting out at the Congress for seeking her resignation, Bharti referred to the 1984 anti-Sikh riots and claimed that then Prime Minister that then Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi had sought to justify the killings post the justify the killings post the assassination of Indira Gan-dhi. Dhinakaran questions need for lookout notice CHENNAI, APRL 19 ./-/ AIADMK leader TTV Dhinakaran today virtually questioned the need for the lookout notice issued by the Dehli Police in a bribery case, saying how could he flee the country when his passport was "in court for 20 years." My assport is in court for 20 years. How can I escape from India, "he told reporters here. He was apparently referring to the pending FERA cases against him in a court here in connection with which he has surrendered his passport. The Dehli Police issued the lookout notice against Dhinakaran in connection with the case registered against thim for allegedly attempting to bribe an EC. The "preventive" action comes in the wake of inputs that Dhinakaran was an NRI and could try to flee, police said. The notice was issued at a time when Dhinakaran has been virtually ousted as Deputy General Secretary of the V K Sasikala faction of AIADMK following a revolt by senior ministers.
