The honour is open to all persons regardless of nationality, race, creed or gender. A jury consisting of the Prime Minister of India, Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Chief Justice of India and two other eminent pers decide the awardee each year. The jury considers such proposals as have been received by the office of the Ministry of Culture up to April 30 of that year for which the award is to be given. Official sources said ordinarily, proposals coming from competent persons invited to nominate are considered. However, a proposal is not taken as invalid for consideration by the jury merely on the ground of not having emanated from com-petent persons. If, however, it is considered that none of the pro-

at year. Only achievements within 10 years immediately preceding the nomination are considered for the award; an older work may, how ever, be considered if its signifishould have been published. The first recipient of the award was Julius K Nyerere, former President of Tanzania in 1995, and in the next year A T Ariyaratne, Founder President of Sarvodaya Sharamadana Movement, Sri Lanka was conferred with the award. In 1997, Gerhard Fischer of Germany received the award. Rama Krishna Mission was selected for the award in 1998 and in 1999. Baba Amte has also received the prestigious award. The award was jointly given in 2000 to Nelson Mandela and Grameen Bank of Bangladesh.
