THRUVANANTHAPURAM, APRIL 20 /-/ Kerala chief minister Pinarayi Vijayan today hit out at the BJP-led NDA government at the Centre and alleged that the saffron party was "using Governors to impose its political interests in states." "BJP satitude is to use Governors for its purpose and what happened in Goa and Manipur is the best example for it; "he said while inaugurating a seminar on Centre-State relations' here.

Referring to the formation of BJP-led governments in Goa and Manipur, Vijayan said Governors of these states did not even invite the party (Congress), which got a majority in the polls, and instead handed over power to a party (BJP) which came second. "It was an undemocratic move and not in tune with the spirit of Constitution. Centre-state relations have become very bad under the BJP government. "Some Central leaders have come out openly stating that he had only the role of an advisor," Vijayan said. Alleging that the Centre was making the states weak, the Left leaders aid the most anti-democratic step was the unitateral dissolution of the Planning Commission. "Another unilateral step was the cutting down of the state's share of resources to 60-40 from 80:20," he said. Vijayan alleged that the agenda was to replace the federal system with "Central authority" in the country. The Delhi Police had also issued a look-out notice against Dhinakaran yesterday. The lookout notice was issued in the wake of inputs that Dhinakaran was an NRI and could try to flee the country. The Crime Branch had on April 16 arrested an alleged middleman, Sukesh Chandrashekhar in New Delhi in connection with the case. He

claimed that he had told Dhinakaran that he will get a favourable verdict from the Election Commission of India in the party symbol case, he said. It has been learnt that he had allegedly struck a deal for Rs 50 crore for helping the AIADMK faction keep the 'two leaves' symbol. Dhinakaran, the nephew of jailed AIADMK general secretary V K Sasikala, is facing a revolt by an influential section of the party led by Chief Minister K Palaniswami and a host of ministers, who had on Tuesday declared the ouster of the once pow clared the ouster of the once po clared the ouster of the once pow-erful aunt-nephew duo, and ex-tended a hand of friendship to the Panneerselvam camp. Thambidurai, also the Deputy Speaker of Lok Sabha, said Rao was his 'friend' and described the meeting as a courtesy call, 'while Finance Minister Jayakumar, who also holds Fisheries portfolio, discussed the issue of Vice-Chancellor's appointment to the Tamil Nadu Fisheries University. 'There is no political significance in the meeting. We did not speak politics at all,' Thambidurai said when asked if he 'apprised' the Governor of the ongoing rumblings in the ruling AIADMK.
Thambidurai said Rao has been his friend since the former was a minister in the AB Vajpayec cabi-

minister in the AB Vajpayee cabi-net in 1998-99. "It was a courtesy call," Thambidurai said, adding, he used to meet Rao, also Governor of

Maharashtra, whenever he visited Mumbai. Thambidurai's meeting with the Governor assumes significance as it came in the wake of changing dynamics in the ruling AlADMK where ministers in the V K Sasikala faction had revolted against their leader TTV Dhinakaran, deciding to keep his family away from the party. They had also initiated the modalities of merging their faction headed by Chief Minister K Palaniswami with the other led by former Chief Minister O Pannerselvam. After meeting the Governor, Jayakumar said it was an official one. 'He is the Chancellor of the Fisheries University and I'm the Pro-Chancellor being the Fisheries Minister I dissity and 1 in the PTO-Chancellor be-ing the Fisheries Minister.
