

China hails Nikki Haley for maintaining dialogue with it at UN

BEIJING, OCT 10 /-/-/ China on Wednesday praised the outgoing US Ambassador to the UN Nikki Haley for maintaining dialogue and cooperation with Beijing on key issues. The 46-year-old Indian-American leader announced Tuesday that she would resign from her post as the US ambassador to the UN by the end of the year. Haley had, as the US ambassador to the UN, maintained dialogue and cooperation with China on many issues, Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Lu Kang told a media briefing on Wednesday when asked about her resignation. China and the US, both permanent members of the UN Security Council (UNSC), share important responsibilities to safeguard international peace and security, Lu added. The UNSC has the US, China, Russia, France and the UK as its five permanent members. US President Donald Trump praised Haley's performance during her tenure as the envoy to the world body. Trump said that he expects to name a replacement for Haley in the next "two to three weeks," and said that he would be participating with the former South Carolina governor and others. (PTI)

Five people on short list to replace Haley as UN ambassador: Trump

WASHINGTON, OCT 10 /-/-/ US President Donald Trump has said he has five persons in mind, including his former deputy national security adviser Dina Powell, to replace Indian-American Nikki Haley as the US ambassador to the UN. Haley, 46, announced Tuesday she would resign from her post as the US ambassador to the UN effective at the end of 2018. Haley's abrupt decision left many in the White House in shock as there was no indication that she planned to leave office. Haley had submitted her resignation on October 3. Trump said Haley would assist in the search for her replacement, and that he plans to settle on a pick in the next two to three weeks. Speaking to reporters aboard Air Force One, Trump identified only one person on the list. He said Powell is on the shortlist of five persons. Trump told reporters "we have actually many names... Nikki is going to help us with the choice. I've heard a lot of names."

Powell served in the first year of the Trump administration as the Deputy National Security Adviser for strategy, and was a key player in diplomatic efforts in the Middle East. She returned to Goldman Sachs, where she worked for more than a decade, earlier this year. She also was a high-ranking official in the State Department of the previous Republican president, George W. Bush, according to the Harvard Kennedy School, where she is a senior fellow. She was instrumental in planning all of Trump's overseas trips as well as his debut at the UN General Assembly in September 2017. "Nikki is a great friend of mine. We've become reacquainted over the last period of time. But she's done a fantastic job. And so she'll be involved. And Dina, certainly. And there are others. I've heard a lot of names," he said. Trump said that Haley would be involved in the administration for a long time even after resigning from the diplomatic position. "Nikki is go-

ing to be involved with us for a long time. And she's going to help me make that final pick. We're going to make a final pick. I want to get somebody really good," Trump told reporters at the White House. Haley, the highest ranking Indian-American in the Trump administration, has agreed to stay till year end as the top American diplomat to the UN. "I think she's also brought a new level of prestige to that position. That position is - in terms of people wanting to be - easier now the way, than it was before. Nikki has brought, obviously, great competence, but she's brought great prestige to that position," Trump said.

Haley, he said would be helping him in his 2020 reelection bid. Responding to a question, Trump said "I think it's important to have someone else over here in the primary for the 2016 presidential election." "It turned out very well for me. She respected work - I guess she said to go, a few times, she wants to work on the 2020 election with us," Trump said. "Rick Grenell is someone I would consider," Trump said, referring to the US ambassador to Germany. But he added that Grenell was not on his short list of five candidates, saying he's doing well in his current post. "I personally like to keep Rick where he is." Along with Powell, other names being floated to replace Haley include US Ambassador to Russia on Hunstman and Acting Under Secretary for Public Diplomacy and Public Affairs Heather Nauert, Fox News reported. Turkey migrant boat capsizes, 4 killed, 30 missing

ANKARA, OCT 10 /-/-/ Turkey's Interior Ministry says a boat carrying migrants has capsized off Turkey's Aegean coast, killing at least four people while 30 others are believed to be missing. The ministry says an Iraqi woman who survived the capsizing made it back to shore and sought help from Turkish authorities after the boat went down Wednesday off the town of Karaburun, in Izmir province. The Coast Guard dispatched vessels, a plane and a helicopter to search for the missing, the ministry said. Although their numbers have decreased in recent years, migrants still try to cross into Greece from nearby Turkey in the hopes of making their way to other European countries. (Agencies)

China 'seriously challenging' Taiwan peace: Tsai

TAIPEI, OCT 10 /-/-/ Taiwan's President Tsai Ing-wen accused China of "seriously challenging" peace and stability Wednesday, describing the island she leads as being on the frontline of tensions in the Pacific. It comes as Beijing pursues a multi-pronged attack on any claims to sovereignty by self-ruled democratic Taiwan, which it sees as part of its territory to be reunified, by force if necessary. Relations between Beijing and Taipei have deteriorated since Tsai took office two years ago, as she refuses to acknowledge that Taiwan is part of "one China". "As Taiwan is on the frontline of the Western Pacific, we

are naturally subject to tremendous pressure," Tsai said in a televised speech to mark Taiwan's National Day. "China's unilateral diplomatic offensive and military coercion have not only harmed cross-strait relations. They have also seriously challenged the status quo of peace and stability in the Taiwan Strait," she added. Taiwan considers itself a sovereign country and has an independent political system, judiciary and currency, but has never formally declared a split, despite being ruled separately since 1949.

China has recently upped military drills around the island and has made a concerted effort to poach Taiwan's dwindling number of official allies - only 17 countries still diplomatically recognise the island after five jumped ship since Tsai took power. Beijing has also successfully put pressure on international businesses to list Taiwan as part of China on their websites and ensured Taiwan is shut out of global forums. Tsai called on authorities in Beijing to "play a positive role in the region and the world, instead of being a source of conflict". She pledged not to escalate tensions but also said Taiwan would seek to fortify its national security and diplomatic links, establishing its "irreplaceable strategic importance".

"I will not be provoked into confrontation or conflicts that endanger cross-strait relations, nor will I deviate from the will of the people, and sacrifice Taiwan's sovereignty," Tsai said. "An effective response strategy must be rooted in national strength," she added. Worsening ties with Beijing and unpopular domestic reforms policies are putting Tsai's government under pressure ahead of major local elections next month. Tsai warned in her speech that anyone interfering in the election process would "suffer serious consequences". She has accused Beijing of spreading "fake information" to affect public trust in the government in the run-up to the vote.

Later Wednesday, thousands of supporters of Taiwan's Beijing-friendly opposition Kuomintang (KMT) party gathered in downtown Taipei, waving flags and singing Taiwan's anthem. Under the former KMT government of President Ma Ying-jeou, from 2008 to 2016, there was an unprecedented rapprochement with Beijing. Ma attended the rally and some participants said they hoped relations with China would improve. "I hope Taiwan and China can maintain peace and not provoke each other," 55-year-old saleswoman Shui Tian

told AFP at the rally. She added that she was disappointed with the lack of Taiwan's national flag on display around the city, blaming the DPP Taiwan's official name is the Republic of China (ROC), and the ROC flag incorporates the white sun on a blue background motif that is the symbol of the KMT. Some pro-independence campaigners want to see the island drop its old name and symbols and establish instead a Republic of Taiwan. The DPP is traditionally pro-independence leaning, but Tsai has always emphasised the importance of maintaining the "status quo" with China. (AFP)

Trump says his daughter Ivanka would be dynamite at UN

WASHINGTON, OCT 10 /-/-/ US President Donald Trump said he is certain that his daughter Ivanka would be "dynamite" as the UN ambassador to the UN, but conceded that he would be "accused of nepotism" if he selected her to replace Indian-American Nikki Haley. Haley, 46, announced Tuesday she would resign from her post as the US ambassador to the UN effective at the end of 2018. As President Trump heaped praise on Haley's performance during her tenure as the envoy to the world body, he said many people would like to replace her. Trump said that he expects to name a replacement for Haley in the next "two to three weeks," and said that he would be talking about candidates with the former South Carolina governor and others. Trump told reporters at the White House that his daughter Ivanka would make an "incredible" ambassador to the UN. "The people that know - it's nothing to do with nepotism. But I want you to know: The people that know, know that Ivanka would be dynamite. But, you know, I'd then be accused of nepotism, if you can believe it," he said. "I think Ivanka would be incredible. That doesn't mean I'd pick her, because you'd be accused of nepotism, even though I'm not sure there's anybody more competent in the world. But that's okay," Trump said in response to a question. Soon after the President's remarks, Ivanka Trump took to Twitter to rule herself out of the running for ambassadorship. (PTI)
