

BJP should hold elections with ballot papers: Uddhav Thackeray

MUMBAI, MAY 15 /-/- Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray today challenged the BJP to hold elections through ballot papers to clear doubts over the use of electronic voting machines (EVMs). As votes for the Karnataka elections were counted and the BJP seemed set to emerge the single largest party, Maharashtra Narmann Sena (MNS) chief Raj Thackeray agreed with Uddhav Thackeray. "This is a victory for the Electronic Voting Machine," he tweeted. Uddhav Thackeray pointed out that the BJP was losing bypolls but winning assembly elections. "If you (BJP) trust yourself, hold elections through ballot papers once," Uddhav Thackeray said, reacting to the Karnataka election results. "When so many people are asking for it, it will clear apprehensions (on the use of EVMs) once and for all," Uddhav Thackeray told reporters. Elections come and go, he added when asked about the Karnataka elections being the first major poll battle after Rahul Gandhi became Congress president. "Sometimes you win, sometimes you lose. One should keep working," he said. The Sena leader congratulated the BJP for its success in Karnataka polls and hoped that people of that state would now witness 'acchhe din'. Former Maharashtra chief minister Prithviraj Chavan said the Congress and the Janata Dal (S) could together form the next government in Karnataka. "If statesmanship is shown, this can happen as we together have a majority in the Karnataka Assembly," the Congress leader told the media. (PTI)

Senalauds Rahul for being dignified while criticising PM Modi

MUMBAI, MAY 10 /-/- The Shiv Sena today praised Congress president Rahul Gandhi for being dignified while attacking Prime Minister Narendra Modi in his speech and said he could pose a challenge to the BJP in 2019. The BJP should have welcomed Gandhi's declaration of his prime ministerial ambitions, the NDA ally said, adding that it was against democracy to make fun of Gandhi or his remark. The BJP should have challenged him to do it in the 2019 general polls. Gandhi had said two days ago that he was ready to occupy the prime minister's post if his party wins the most seats in the 2019 Lok Sabha polls, making known his ambition for the top executive post. Reacting to the comment, Modi wondered whether the country would ever accept a leader who was immature and a dynast for the post. Rebuking the BJP for criticising Gandhi's comments, the Sena said people would decide if the Congress president would become the prime minister in 2019 or face defeat.

However, saying that he (Gandhi) is eager to become the prime minister or making fun of him is against democracy," it said in an editorial in the party mouthpiece 'Samak' today. There is democracy left in the country, the BJP should have welcomed Gandhi's statement and challenged him to defeat it in 2019, the Sena said. Lavishing praise on the 47-year-old Congress leader, the Sena said, "Rahul Gandhi today is not the same as he was in 2014.

He has become a strong-minded person after bearing criticism. He can pose a challenge to the BJP in 2019 and the Gujarat Assembly polls have proved this." According to the Uddhav Thackeray-led party, the BJP uses 'derogatory' language against Gandhi but he has never stooped to those levels to attack Modi and has respected him as prime minister. Gandhi's opponents have to agree that he has maintained a "certain degree of political class," the Sena said.

Taking a jibe at Modi, it said, "The PM has started remembering his 'Alia dhama' now. We are happy to hear that." It said the BJP thinks there is no dialogue between the Congress and its allies. But what has been the BJP's level of interaction with its coalition partner, the NDA ally, it asked. "The BJP has taken decisions in the interest of the country that have been taken by working together, the bickering ally sought to know. Allies were being 'stabbed in the back' with the sword of power, which the BJP got due to the collective efforts of NDA partners, the Marathi daily said. If the BJP asks how Gandhi can be the contender for the prime ministerial post when there are seniors in the Congress and UPA allies, then the BJP should ask L. K. Advani and Murli Manohar Joshi will be the right persons to answer, the Sena quipped.

Sr lawyer Mukul Rohatgi appointed as eminent jurist in Lokpal panel: Govt

NEW DELHI, MAY 15 /-/- Senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi was appointed as an eminent jurist in the selection committee for appointment of anti-graft ombudsman Lokpal, the Centre told the Supreme Court today. Attorney General K Venugopal told a bench headed by Justice Ranjan Gogoi that a decision was taken on May 11 to appoint Rohatgi as an eminent jurist in the selection committee which is chaired by the Prime Minister. Rohatgi was appointed the Attorney General of India after the Narendra Modi government assumed power in May 2014. He resigned from the post of eminent jurist in the Lokpal selection panel was leaving vacant since the death

of senior advocate P P Rao on September 11, 2017. The committee comprises of the Prime Minister, the Chief Justice of India, Lok Sabha Speaker, the leader of the largest opposition party and an eminent jurist. The bench, on hearing the submissions, posted the matter for hearing on July 2. It was hearing a contempt petition filed by NGO Common Cause, which had raised the issue of non-appointment of the eminent jurist despite the apex court's verdict of April 27 last year. The Centre had on April 17 told the apex court that a recommendation for induction of an eminent jurist in the selection committee for the appointment of Lokpal was made at a recent meeting of the panel chaired by the

Prime Minister and approval was awaited. The apex court had observed that since the steps for the appointment had already been taken, there was no need to pass any further order at this stage. Venugopal had told the bench that at the April 10 meeting of selection panel, the recommendation "for induction/appointment of an eminent jurist in the committee has been made and approval of the said recommendation is presently pending". Senior advocate P P Rao was earlier appointed as an eminent jurist in the committee but the post vacant after his death last year. The apex court, in its last year's verdict, had said there was no justification to keep the enforcement of

Lokpal Act suspended till the proposed amendments, including on the issue of the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, were cleared by Parliament. It had said the Act was an eminently workable piece of legislation and "does not create any bar to the enforcement of provisions".

The top court had also said that the amendments proposed to the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act 2013, and the views of the Parliamentary Standing Committee, were attempts to streamline the working of the Act and did not constitute legal hindrance or bar its enforcement. The judgement had come on a plea by the NGO and others seeking immediate appointment of the Lokpal. (PTI)

Safdar Nagori, 17 SIMI cadres sentenced to 7-yr RI in Kerala

KOCHI, MAY 15 /-/- A special NIA court here sentenced 18 SIMI members, including its leader Safdar Nagori, to seven years of rigorous imprisonment (RI) today, after they were found guilty of organising an arms training camp for the members of the banned outfit in Kerala in 2007. Special NIA court Judge Kausar Edappagath also sentenced the convicts to varying terms of imprisonment under different sections of the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA), the Explosive Substances Act (ESA) and section 120-B (criminal conspiracy) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

The court sentenced to one-year RI under section 10 and five-year RI under section 38 of the UAPA, seven-year RI under section 4 of the ESA and seven-year RI under section 120-B, IPC, of the convicts. 13 were also found guilty under section 20 of the UAPA (punishment for being a member of a terrorist organisation/

gang) and sentenced to seven years of RI. The court imposed a fine of Rs 1 lakh each on the 13 convicts found guilty under various sections, including section 20 of the UAPA. A fine of Rs 50,000 each was slapped on the remaining five, who were found guilty under other sections.

The judge said the sentences would run concurrently and set-offs would be allowed. Fourteen of the convicts, who have been in judicial custody for more than seven years, will get the benefit of set-off allowed by the court, a defence lawyer said. Under section 428 of Cr.Pc, the period of detention undergone by an accused during investigation or trial will be set-off against the period of his imprisonment. The court in today's verdict sentenced today were - Sadulji, P A Shibly, Mohammed Ansar and Abdul Sathar (all from Kerala); Hafeez Hussain, Mohammed Sami Bagevali, Nadeem Sayeed, Dr H A Asadulla, Shakeel Ahmed and Mirza Ahmed Baig (Karnataka); Aamil Parwaz and Kamaruddin Nagori (Madhya Pradesh); Mufi Abul Bashtar (Uttar Pradesh); Danish and Manzar Imam (Jharkhand); Mohammed Abu Faisal Khan (Maharashtra); and Alam Job Afridi (Gujarat). Veteran journalist Mark Tully bags RedInk Award

The RedInk awards for excellence in journalism are instituted by the Mumbai Press Club. Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis and Union Commerce Minister Suresh Prabhu will present the award to Tully on May 18 in Mumbai, the Mumbai Press Club said in a statement. The lifetime achievement award to Tully is the recognition of his long and outstanding contribution to Indian journalism, it said. Tully worked with the BBC for 30 years before resigning in July 1994. He held the position of Chief of Bureau, BBC, Delhi, for 20 years. Meanwhile, Faye D'Souza, the executive editor of Mirror Now channel, has been selected as the winner of the RedInk award for "journalist of the year". The statement said that D'Souza's "passionate and honest" style, with which she handled subjects like corruption, political opportunism, price rise and communalism, made her and her programme 'The Urban Debate' a subject of "appointment viewing". Apart from these two awards, the RedInk awards for excellence in journalism are given in 13 competitive categories to 29 journalists after a process of selection by a jury appointed for each category. Court seeks CBI's response on journalist's bail plea

NEW DELHI, MAY 15 /-/- A Delhi court has asked the CBI to respond to the bail plea of journalist Uppendra Rai, who is under arrest for his alleged involvement in a dubious financial transaction. Special CBI Judge Santosh Sushil Mani directed the central probe agency to respond by May 18 on Rai's application which has claimed that no purpose will be served by keeping him in further custody. Rai, arrested by the CBI on May 3, is currently in the judicial custody. The Delhi bench said Rai was arrested for allegedly indulging in dubious financial transactions and getting an airport access pass made by the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) by furnish-

ing false information. In his bail application, Rai has said he was not required for further custodial interrogation since the CBI's plea for this was rejected by the court on May 9.
