**Cong can't see 'achhey din' due to SP alliance: UP BJP chief**

**LUCKNOW, JAN 31 /-** Launching a scathing attack on political rivals, Uttar Pradesh BJP chief Keshav Prasad Maurya today said "scam-tainted" Congress could not see 'achhey din' after entering into a pre-poll alliance with Samajwadi Party which is "infamous for patronising corrupt and criminals". "The hurdles created by tangling wires during a joint road show by two 'yuvajs' in the state capital exposed false promises by Samajwadi Party (SP) in the name of development," the Phulpur MP said in a statement. "Congress can't see 'achhey din' after entering into a pre-poll alliance with Samajwadi Party which is infamous for patronising criminal and land mafias. Work done for poor, farmers and common man by Centre is known to all," he said. Maurya alleged, "Rs 100 crore was embezzled in the name of improving power distribution system, but when such a situation (pre-quent power outages) exists in the capital, power system in other districts can easily be assessed." The state BJP president said Modi government was generating more than 76,000 MW power and was heading towards traditional generation of 16655.5 MW in the current fiscal. "To improve power system in states, the central government launched 'Uday scheme', but UP government did not provide figures relating demand and supply," Maurya said, adding that the biggest achievement of Uttar Pradesh (UP) is that it tops the list of power deficit states. "As compared to UP, BJP-ruled states including Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan are providing additional power and providing 24 hours power supply. They are also augmenting their revenue by providing power to industries," he added. Assembly elections in Uttar Pradesh will be held from February 11 to March 8 in 7 phases. (PTI)

**CBI takes over probe in extortion case against Rajan**

**NEW DELHI, JAN 31 /-** CBI has taken over investigation in the case pertaining to alleged extortion demand of Rs 26 crore by gang members of Chhota Rajan from a Mumbai-based builder in 2015. Mumbai Police, which was probing the case, had filed a charge sheet last year against Suresh Shinde, Ashok Nikam, Sanjit Mhatre, Nikhil Awagade showing three main accused Chhota Rajan, Anolachi Isam and Parmanand Thakkar as "absconding accused". It is alleged that a call was made to the builder asking him to pay Rs 26 crore to Thakkar else he and his wife will be killed by the gang, according to the FIR filed.

**I have Netaji's blessings, will win over 300 seats: Akhilesh**

**HATHRAS (UP), JAN 31 /-** Dismissing his uncle Shival Yadav's threat today to float a new party, Samajwadi Party president and Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Akhilesh Yadav said he has the blessings of his father and the "entire family is one". "The entire family is one...I have the blessings of Netaji...we will win over 300 (of the 403) seats in alliance with Congress this time," Akhilesh told a public meeting in Sikandaru for the candidates of the SP-Congress alliance on Saturday, Sikandaru and Hathras seats. Earlier in the day Shival had said, "I will form a new party after March 11 when results of UP Assembly elections are out. You make the government, we will make a new party." Akhilesh also talked of his party's alliance with the Congress in the rally. "I had come here in 2012 and today I come again and also brought the election symbol of Congress 'hand' with our own 'bicycle'." "With hand, the bicycle will run faster," he stressed. Cautioning people against BJP, Akhilesh alleged that it belonged to those who tell "lies". "The Prime Minister speaks about his 'Mann Ki Baat' on TV but 'man to chanchal hota hai' it keeps changing its stand... people of the country were made to

**Shival threatens sabotage after filing papers as SP nominee**

**ETA WAH/HATHRAS (UP), JAN 31 /-** Holding out an open threat of sabotage, Shival Singh Yadav today said he would campaign for Samajwadi Party rebels in the assembly election and float a new party after the polls, soon after filing his nomination as an SP candidate. The defiant declaration from Shival came days after Samajwadi Party patriarch Mulayam Singh Yadav voiced his displeasure over the SP-Congress alliance and said he would not campaign for it. "You make the government, we will make a new party after March 11," Shival said, the estranged uncle of SP president and UP Chief Minister Akhilesh Yadav said, drawing a sharp retort from his nephew who warned in Etah that those working against the party will not be spared. On the campaign trail, Akhilesh, despite voicing displeasure over Shival's statement, chose not to announce action against his uncle and precipitate a fresh crisis in the party, yet to recover from the trauma

of estrangement between Mulayam and his son, who got the mantle of SP president after the Election Commission settled the intra-party dispute over its control in his favour. Addressing an election rally in Sikandaru, Akhilesh claimed he had the "blessings of Netaji (Mulayam)" and that "the entire family is one". "There was a lot of speculation but I have for now filed my nomination papers as a Samajwadi Party candidate. But where will my people go? Where will those who toiled hard for SP for the last five years go? They are contesting in some places and the rest doing nothing," Shival said and went on to assert he will campaign for the "rebels" fighting against official nominees of SP-Congress alliance. Shival's assertion, political analysts claim, could go against the SP-Congress combine, which has been hoping for a solid consolidation of Muslim voters in its favour. Muslims, who had for decades since independence stood rock solid

behind the Congress, drifted away from it and backed Mulayam's party in the aftermath of the Babri Masjid demolition. A three-way split in Muslim votes—among Mulayam loyalists, SP-Congress combine and Mayawati's BSP—would benefit BJP which is seeking to keep back to power in the stormy UP state after a hiatus of 15 years. If Shival carries out the threat and campaigns for the rebels, it would also create confusion among SP's Yadav vote bank. 61-year-old Shival said he had entered the fray on an SP ticket going against his supporters who wanted him to contest as an independent. He attacked Akhilesh over Mulayam's "humiliation", which he asserted "will not be tolerated". Shival, who got the ticket after Mulayam intervened, said those who acknowledged "Netaji led the party's rise have now publicly humiliated him. I repeatedly requested Akhilesh not to insult Mulayam Singh but he did not listen." (PTI)

# No stay on new Jallikattu law, Tamil Nadu to maintain peace: SC

**NEW DELHI, JAN 31 /-** In a relief to Jallikattu supporters, the Supreme Court today refused to stay the new legislation passed recently by the Tamil Nadu assembly but warned the state government not to allow commotion on the streets, reminding that law and order was its prime duty.

The apex court also permitted the Centre to withdraw the January 7, 2016 notification allowing Jallikattu in Tamil Nadu. What was the need for the situation? Why does this situation crop up? There was a situation which needed to be controlled.

Please tell your executive that maintaining law and order situation is its prime duty. You please convey this," a bench of Justices Dipak Misra and R F Nariman told the advocates appearing for Tamil Nadu. The apex court permitted animal rights bodies and other individuals to amend their pending petitions for challenging the new legislation. During the hearing, Attorney General Mukul Rohatgi said the Centre has filed an interlocutory application seeking to withdraw the January 7, 2016 notification and stated that petitions challenging it had become infructuous. Animal

rights organisations which have challenged the notification opposed Centre's plea and said the application to withdraw the notification was not maintainable at this stage when the court has reserved its order on December 7, 2016. "Notification is an executive act and legislature has given power to the executive to do that."

There was a notification which we have stayed. Now there is a legislation which we will deal with," the bench said. The Attorney General said the notification is a delegated legislation and petitions challenging it can no more be

**Priyanka has restricted her political role to Amethi and Rae Bareilly: Cong**

**PANAJI, JAN 31 /-** Clearing the air on the future role of Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, especially when she has played an important part in sewing the alliance with the Samajwadi Party in Uttar Pradesh, the Congress today said she has, for the "time being", restricted her political role to Rae Bareilly and Amethi of her "own volition". "Priyanka has always defined her own political role and of her own volition, has restricted it to the two (Lok Sabha) constituencies represented by her mother and brother, that is Rae Bareilly and Amethi respectively," Congress chief spokesperson Randeep Surjewala told PTI in an interview here.

Surjewala was in Goa to campaign for the February 4 Assembly election. "Many Congress workers have demanded that she (Priyanka) play an active role. We have always respected her privacy and decision. It is her call to take (on her role) as has been said by Rahulji (Congress president Rahul Gandhi)," he said. Stating that Priyanka has to decide about her political role "on her own", the Congress

leader said she has "confined herself to the two Parliamentary constituencies for the time being". "Rahulji has said many times that he would be very happy if she (Priyanka) plays a more proactive role, but it is a decision that has to be taken by her," Surjewala said.

The speculation about Priyanka's active participation in politics, at a time when Rahul is leading from the front while Congress president Sonia Gandhi is becoming less active due to her health, became intense after she played a crucial role in salvaging the Congress SP coalition talks for the high stake Uttar Pradesh Assembly election. Priyanka was also said to be instrumental in bringing Navjot Singh Sidhu and some other leaders into the party fold ahead of the elections to five state assemblies. Her name figures among the 40 star campaigners her party has finalised for Uttar Pradesh. However, neither Priyanka nor her mother Sonia has campaigned for the Congress candidates in Goa whereas, Rahul has so far, addressed two public meetings in the coastal state. (PTI)

**US denies visa to Kashmiri athletes**

**SRINAGAR, JAN 31 /-** Two snowshoos from Kashmir have alleged they have been denied visa to the US over the current US policy. "Indian Snowshoos Denied Visas, due to 'current US policy'." This from our good friend and US policy analyst, Samer Hussain. They were supposed to take part in the 2017 World Snowshoe Championships in New York on February 24-25. There was no immediate reaction from US Embassy officials who were contacted for comments on the issue. **Misunderstanding about 'Padmavati' clarified: Bhansali production**

**MUMBAI, JAN 31 /-** In the wake of protests by Shree Rajput Sabha in Jaipur, Bhansali's production house today said that misunderstanding regarding the content of the film has been clarified with Shree Rajput Sabha. The production house told the Rajput body that there is no romantic dream sequence between Rani Padmavati and Alauddin Khilji. The film has been cleared by Shree Rajput Sabha. Bhansali Productions said, "Shri Giriraj ji Lotwara, President of Shree Rajput Sabha has been extremely helpful in bringing the various Rajput organisations, including the Karni Sena, Sangh Shakti, Pratap Foundation, Bhawani Niketan to state to clarify this," the statement said. Last week, Bhansali had been roughed up by members of the Rajput Karni Sena, who also stopped the shooting by damaging the set at Jaigarh Fort, alleging that the director was "distorting facts" in the movie which is about Alauddin Khilji's obsession with Rani Padmavati. After the incident, the "Padmavati" team is apparently back in Mumbai. Jointly produced by Bhansali and Viacom 18 Motion Pictures, the film is scheduled for release in November this year. (PTI)

**Modi's tenure marked by "RSS ka saath, BJP ka vikas": Cong**

**NEW DELHI, JAN 31 /-** Voicing disappointment with the President's address to the joint sitting of Parliament, Congress today said the Narendra Modi government had failed to fulfil its promises and its stint was marked by "RSS ka saath, BJP ka vikas". Addressing a joint press conference, Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha Ghulam Nabi Azad and Congress leader in the Lok Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge parodied the Prime Minister's slogan of "sabka saath, sabka vikas" (together will all, development for all), made during general elections, and said his tenure had seen the government only caring for the benefit of RSS and BJP. Modi's actions have led to "RSS ka saath, BJP ka vikas", they said.

**Remark reflects Rahul's disappointment, frustration: BJP**

**NEW DELHI, JAN 31 /-** Commenting on the President's address today took a swipe at Rahul Gandhi for his remark that the Centre was a "complete failure" on job creation front, saying it was indicative of his "disappointment and frustration" at not having a job and suggesting him to join a government-run skill centre to get employment. Urban Development Minister M Venkaiah Naidu said that the Congress vice president's remark was outcome of his "disappointment and frustration". Congress is not in a position to stand on its own feet, that is why it has to sit "on the carrier of a cycle" in Uttar Pradesh, he said, referring to the Congress-SP alliance in the poll-bound state. "He did not get employment what can we do? His party is failing in every stage. He is not in a position to stand on his own feet. Such an old party and it had to sit on the carrier of a cycle in UP. That is why due to his disappointment and frustration, he might have interpreted it like this," Naidu told reporters outside Parliament.

"If you find fault with the President's address, it does not mean you find fault with the President, it is the government with which you are finding fault and are disappointed with." The President's address talks about 'sabka saath, sabka vikas'. This was a slogan coined by the Prime Minister ahead of elections to seek votes, which he did not implement. He instead brought about 'RSS ka saath, BJP ka vikas' and no section of society is happy today," Azad said. He said all promises made to farmers, labourers, youth, dalits and minorities have remained unfulfilled, and all sections feel neglected, while unemployment has increased. Azad also said even though his party supported the "surgical strikes", ceasefire violations along the border with Pakistan have risen ever since, leading to death of a large number of soldiers. "The government should clarify on this," he demanded. "The past year has not been good for economy and along the border," he said. Claiming that whatever government said on demonetisation was proved wrong and the money scrapped had come back into the system almost in entirety, he demanded an explanation from the government as to why Rs 15,000-20,000 crore was spent on demonetisation.
