MP reviews implementation of centrally sponsored schemes

PORT BLAIR, JULY 6/-/ The District Development

Coordination and Monitoring Committee (DDMC)/DISHA meeting was held recently in the conference hall of Zilla Parishad (SA) under the chairmanship of Member of Parliament, Lok Sabha, A & N Islands to review all the Centrally Sponsored Schemes being implemented by different departments of A & N Administration. The meeting was attended by Mr. Uditi Prakash Rai, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman District and Ms. Kirti Garg, Deputy Commissioner, N & E Andaman, Mr. Krishan Kumar, CEO, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman and by all the Head of the departments. The Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman District)/Member Secretary (DISHA)



presented a power point presentation reflecting all the 28 CSS being monitored under DISHA. The Chairman, DISHA mainly discussed on the topics related to Electricity, water, road, agriculture and education and directed all the concerned departments / authorities to initiate action to provide electricity,

water, agricultural facilities and road in all the remote areas through CSS. The chairman expressed his concern on the quality of education system prevailing in the remote Islands of A & N Islands and he discussed on the points related to quality education, recruitment of teachers, introduction of

vocational courses in intermediate classes in collaboration with Kamaraj English Medium School and Umnat Public Senior Secondary School and also emphasized on changing the transfer policy for teachers posted at Southern group of Islands. The Chairman appreciated Secretary (RD) for his immense

contribution in Agriculture department, implementing NRLM scheme in these Islands. It was also decided to convene a meeting with BSNL to sort out the network problem faced all the time by the residents of A & N Islands and also to convene a meeting with the head of Fisheries department and Veterinary department in District Level. He also stressed on the need to enhance the wages of ASHA workers and to have transparency in procuring Medicines under NIHM.

Two held with 2.7 kilos of ganja

PORT BLAIR, JULY 6/-/ The Police Station Aberdeen busted two cases of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 and arrested two persons with over 2.70 kg of illicit Ganja from Atlanta Point. After receiving credible information by SHO PS Aberdeen that Krishna Raj @ Babu, private worker R/o Dignabad is earning his livelihood by selling illicit ganja and he was in possession of huge quantity of ganja and intended to sell the same to local people, a raiding team led by Insp. Arun Kumar Singh, SHO PS Aberdeen, HC V. Hentho, PC D. Shiv Kumar, PC Sudeep Kumar and PC Suresh was formed under the direct supervision of SDPO(SA) Shri. Nishant Gupta. The team busted the NDPS racket and recovered 1.6 Kg of illicit ganja from the possession of accused person namely Krishna Raj @ Babu and he was arrested under NDPS Act, 1985.

On questioning, he revealed that another person namely Ram Prasad Ghosh @ Swamy is also involved in selling illicit ganja and he also has huge haul of ganja with him. On this disclosure, the above mentioned raiding team again came into action and recovered 1.180 kg of illicit ganja from the possession of the accused person namely Ram Prasad Ghosh @ Swamy (51 yrs) R/o Atlanta Point and arrested him under the sections of Narcotic Drug and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985. The entire operation took place under the direction of Insp. A.K. Singh, SHO PS Aberdeen and overall supervision of SDPO (SA) Mr Nishant Gupta.
