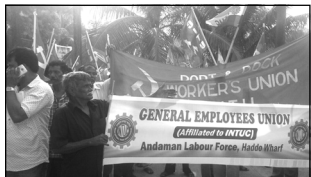

Kuldeep, Chandrachoodan Vigilance Awareness Week lead demonstrations

PORT BLAIR, OCT 30 - A joint demonstration by the General Employees Union led by its president Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma and Port & Dock Workers Union led by its president Mr. B. Chandrachoodan was staged in front of Port Management Board Administrative building on Monday to express anguish of the workers of Andaman Labour Force and Shipping Godown, PMB for non-payment of incentives for handling of cargo more than the fixed norms, payment of additional wages and night duty allowance for the past over five months despite being engaged to perform extra work.

Both leaders invited the attention of the administration that the scheme for payment of incentive to stevedores of ALP was introduced by the A & N Administration during 1975 with



the approval of Ministry of Affairs, Govt. of India and still in force without any amendments facilitating quick loading/unloading of cargo to increase turnaround time of ships. In view of introduction of modern cargo handling equipments in the Ports of Port Blair, a fresh Memorandum of Settlement for the upward revision of norms for handling various category of cargo has already been done between the Management and Union, therefore holding back incentives of workers is not legitimate. The demonstration was called off with the assurance from the Chief Port Administrator to convene a joint meeting of the Administration, Port Management Board and the unions under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary who is also the chairman of Port Management Board within a period of two-three days to settle the issue.

BRAIT induction programme concludes befittingly

PORT BLAIR, OCT 30 - Mr. Udit Prakash Rai, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman motivated in his speech on 'GenNext-Career after Engineering' on the concluding day of the week-long induction programme for the BRAIT students (freshers). Mr. Rai urged students to take up the challenges in life as there is no substitute to hard work. Ms. C. Raji, Principal of Kendriya Vidyalaya spoke on challenges and influence of being a Rotarian. Cong turned Himachal into land of criminals, says Yogi

SHIMLA, OCT 30 - Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath has slammed the Virbhadra government in Himachal Pradesh, accusing it of turning "dev bhoomi" into "apraadh bhoomi".
Canvassing for BJP candidates at Arki and Haroli on Sunday, Adityanath charged that only crime and corruption has increased under Congress rule in Himachal and urged the people of Himachal Pradesh to vote for the BJP. "The Congress has turned the 'dev bhoomi' (land of Gods) into 'apraadh bhoomi' (land of crime). It has sullied the name of the state, which is now known for wine forests and mining mafia, and illegal activities," he charged.

DoT allocates no1076 for UP CM helpline

NEW DELHI, OCT 30 - The department of telecom (DoT) has allocated '1076' as the number for UP chief minister's helpline to which the public can call and register complaints once it is operational. "The undersigned is directed to convey the approval for short code '1076' to government of Uttar Pradesh for its chief minister helpline..." a DoT order said. The helpline number will be operated by UP chief minister office (CMO) with help of call centre with manpower of 500 people. As per a report, chief minister Yogi Adityanath has ordered to set up CM Helpline on which people can register their grievances. The staff will note down the complaint and forward it to the department concerned for appropriate action. The progress on complaints will be monitored by CM office, as per the proposal. The number is reportedly expected to be operational by the end of this year. (PTI)
