Joint opposition lashes out at Centre on black day

PORT BLAIR, NOV 10/-/ As part of the call of opposition parties against demonetisation and GST and to observe Nov 9 as 'Black Day', a public meeting was held jointly by Andaman Nicobar Pradesh Congress Committee, DMK and CPI(M) at Tiranga Park, Port Blair in front of a large gathering.

Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, President, Pradesh Congress party described demonetisation as a Himalayan blunder of Mr. Modi, destroying India's reliable cash economy hitting out at honest poor, farmers, labourers, artisans, small shopkeepers, businesses, fisherman, vegetable vendors, road side vendors and housewives. Entire country lined up at ATMS and several died in queues while thousands were unable to meet their medical, marriages, education expenses and more on account of cashlessness. He said that NDA Government has broken its electoral promises such as recovering black money in foreign banks, employment, checking price rise, cross border terrorism etc.

He said that Mr. Modi in a rush swept off 86% of country's high denomination currency. Within a year of this, imposition of the deceptive Goods and Service Taxes (GST) on common masses has broken the financial backbone of the country. Islanders too are worst hit by the GST, as being an UT and administered by GOI, there was either no tax or very meager taxes, but now we are burdened with two kind of taxes CGST and UTGST. Ms. Shanta Singh, Mr. Noor Islam, Mr. Tamil Selvam, Senior leaders of Pradesh Congress committee in their address



elaborated the sufferings faced by fishermen, tourism sector, small traders and common man here due to demonetisation and GST wiping out people's earning and creating an enormous sense of fear and insecurity. Mr. Laxman Rao, Mr. K.G. Das and Mr. Banerji, Senior leaders of CPI (M) said how demonetisation caused price rise, joblessness particularly in the unorganised sector and slowed down the country's economy and that it was a politically motivated publicity stunt to divert the attention of the country from the real social issues as barring 1% of banned currency all have come back, the cross border terrorism in rise and fake currency is back. Mr. A. R. Marudhavanan, State Chief Organiser DMK and senior leaders like Mr. Senthil, Mr. Kulanthai, Mr. Kannan said that the demonetisation has affected each aspect of our lives breaking the backbone of the Indian economy. Vote of thanks proposed by Mr. A. R. Marudhavanan, State Chief Organiser DMK, who spelt the need for organising joint meetings frequently to expose the anti people policies of NDA.

Special video classes at IGNOU today

PORT BLAIR, NOV 10/-/ The Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) through its Electronic Media Production Centre has been producing thousands of audio and video CDs on various subjects for learners. The Port Blair Regional Centre (RC) library has over 100 such CDs on curriculum based lectures and discussion.

To facilitate the students of Port Blair, the Regional Centre is starting special Video Classes on 11th November (Saturday) between 10 am and 1 pm. PVCHR writes to ANI DGP

PORT BLAIR, NOV 10/-/ The letter from Peoples Vigilance Committee on Human Rights (PVCHR) to Director General of Police, A&N Islands reads- "We are hereby sorry to inform you that we have been receiving several complaints against police alleged violations of human rights and torture and even misuse of power which is a matter of serious concern, as well know that, police is the protector of law and their duty is to protect the human rights of citizen."

We have been trying our best to have a better police and public relations by organising several awareness and training programmes in association with various social departments, educational department, Inner Wheel Club, Youth for Human Rights International, Citizen Forum on Human Rights to make human rights a ground reality, instead of this we have been noticing negligence from even educated officers of police departments and their violation of human rights, and there is a fear among general public for their security and safety. We have already taken up this issue, with National Human Rights Commission, New Delhi in the month of January 2017 in the presence of former Chief Justice of India, Mr. H. L. Dattu, Chairperson (NHRC), Chief Secretary and then Director General of Police, Mr. Rajesh Mallick. Hence request you to intervene as we always feel that the police are the friends of people and they are here to protect the law and punish the culprits, social evils and criminals, not innocent people and not to spoil their life. We request you to carry an departmental inquiry to find the facts at ground level as we have been visiting parts of islands from time to time and receiving information on violation.
Madam, hope you will take necessary action on these police or police officers. We are expecting a change in the police system of these beautiful islands under your able leadership.
