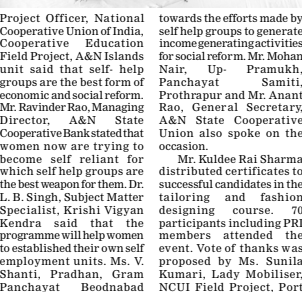
## Payment released under PMMVY

**PORT BLAIR DEC 22** - Ministry of Women & Child Development launched the scheme Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana on 1st January 2017 for its Pan-India implementation and this scheme was officially launched in this UT on 14th September, 2017. Under the scheme, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers for first child in family, excluding those who are in regular employment with Central/State Government or Public Sector Undertakings or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law, are eligible after 01.01.2017. This scheme provides a cash incentive of Rs. 5000/- in three installments which would be paid to the beneficiaries' bank account in DBT mode through PFMS on the following conditions. First installment of Rs. 2000 is paid after registration of pregnancy in a Health institution along with registration at the nearest Anganwadi Centre.

The Second Installment of Rs. 2000 is paid after completion of 6 months of pregnancy and at least 1 Antenatal Check-up at the Health Centre and the Third Installment of Rs. 2000 is paid after child birth is registered and the child has received the first cycle of vaccination. So far, a total of 1074 beneficiaries in this UT have been registered online and Directorate of Social Welfare has released first installment to 189 beneficiaries through PFMS on 16th December, 2017. The amount will get reflected in the bank account of beneficiaries within a week from the date of payment release. All eligible beneficiaries are requested to enroll themselves in the nearest Anganwadi Centre so as to avail benefit under this scheme. The beneficiaries will have to submit documents such as a copy of Aadhaar document of the beneficiary and her Husband, Antenatal Card, bank account, child birth certificate and immunization card of the child along with the application.

## Training programmes at Beodnabad by NCUI

**PORT BLAIR, DEC 22** - The National Cooperative Union of India, Cooperative Education Field Project (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Department of Cooperation), A&N Islands unit has organised an inaugural programme for 9-day leadership development for self-help groups, and a certification course for three months on tailoring and fashion designing at Beodnabad Panchayat Hall. In a function held on Thursday at Beodnabad Panchayat Hall, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, Chairman, A&N State Cooperative Union was the chief guest. ## Skill Dev Trng to Rural Youth by KVK

**RANGAT, DEC 22** - KVK, N&M Andaman organised two training programmes on 'Responsible Harvest and Quality Standards for Marine Fish Export' and 'Integrated Production Practices for Oil Seed Crops' at Uttara and Kadamtala respectively. A 3 day programme at Uttara Gram Panchayat Hall was inaugurated by Ms. Saraswati Bawali, Pradhan, Gram Panchayat Uttara in presence of Up-Pradhan, PRIs and farmers. Ms. Bawali expressed for need of such programmes for improving skills of youth for self employment in rural areas. The programme and urged attention for obtaining maximum benefit from it. Dr. Shailesh Kumar, SMS (Fisheries) briefed about the programme and urged the farmers and participants to adopt scientific methods of marine fish harvest for maintaining export quality and improved returns in a sustainable way. Experts of KVK Dr. Nagesh Ram, Sr. Scientist and Head, Dr. Shailesh Kumar and Mr. B. L. Meena, SMS, Agronomy had interactive sessions on different topics such as rights and responsibilities of fishermen in sustaining fish harvest, scientific post-harvest practices in sea, code of conduct for responsible fisheries, scope of fish export and regional trade, quality control and marketing of fish and fish products, trends, issues and development to sustain fishery industries etc. Film shows on modern fish harvesting methods, fish processing and fish products development were screened. Integrated production practices for oil seed crops was discussed at Uttara. Experts of KVK Dr. Nagesh Ram, Mr. B. L. Meena, Mr. Dhananjay Das and Dr. Shailesh Kumar and Department of Agriculture held technical sessions on topics like scope and importance of oil seed crops in the islands, agronomic practices, integrated nutrient management, pest and disease management, post-harvest and value addition in oil seed crops etc.



Visuals were also shown to the participants on scientific cultivation of oil seed crops developed by ICAR institutes. ## Agromet bulletin for farmers

**PORT BLAIR, DEC 22** - The Central Island Agricultural Research Institute has released the agromet bulletin for farmers for the period from Dec 23 to 27, 2017. In the bulletin, CIARI forecasts partly cloudy weather with light rainfall is likely to occur in the next five days. In South Andaman 19 mm of rainfall, in North and Middle Andaman 10 mm of rainfall and in Nicobar Island 75 mm of moderate rainfall is expected during this period. The maximum temperature will be 26 to 31 degree centigrade with minimum temperature of 23 to 28 degree centigrade, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 72 to 79 % and 63 to 75 %, respectively in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speed of 15 to 25 kmph is expected from North Easterly direction.

## Formation of Anticipated Low Pressure

**PORT BLAIR, DEC 22** - A low pressure area is likely to develop over south Andaman Sea and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal around December 25. Under the influence of this system, heavy rain (07-11cm) likely to occur at isolated places over Nicobar Islands during the next 48 hours. Strong winds speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusts to 55 kmph would prevail along and off Nicobar Islands around December 25 and sea condition would be generally rough. Fishermen are advised to be cautious while venturing into the sea. Daily updated forecast will be issued in this regard. The general public is advised to take precautionary measures and contact the State Control Room, District Control Room and Emergency Operation Centres in case of any emergency contact.
