

Massive demonstration by ASNVMs against Labour Commissioner, APWDCE

PORT BLAIR, AUG 3/-/ Andaman Sarvajnik Nirman Vibhag Mazdoor Sangh (ASNVMs) affiliated to CITU organised a mass demonstration in front of the offices of the Labour Commissioner at Supply Line and Chief Engineer, APWD on Thursday to protest against the illegal and unjustified opinion given by the Labour Commissioner to the Chief Engineer, APWD about the implementation of the 1/30th of pay plus DA scheme to daily rated mazoors of APWD. Hundreds of workers working in APWD at Port Blair and South Andaman areas participated in the programme. Addressing the gathering, Mr B. Chandrachud, president of the ASNVMs said that the Administration's Office Memorandum No. 289 dated 22nd September, 2017 to extend the benefit of 1/30th of pay plus DA scheme of the Govt. of India to the daily rated mazoors has been partially implemented in APWD and a large section of DRMs were left out due to the wrong advice tendered by the Labour Commissioner. The Labour Commissioner, in a most brazen violation of the existing rules and orders, has advised the Chief Engineer that only those daily rated mazoors who have completed 240 days' continuous service in a calendar year is eligible for getting the benefit of 1/30th of pay plus DA scheme, a



condition which is not included in the Govt. of India's 1988 original scheme or in the Office Memorandum dated 22nd September, 2017. After the mass demonstration in front of the office of the Labour Commissioner, the workers took out a procession which culminated in a mass demonstration in front of the office of the Chief Engineer, APWD. The other demands raised by the Union include regularisation of the services of daily rated mazoors working in various Divisions of APWD, grant of 1/30th of pay plus DA to all DRMs, grant of bonus to all DRMs, etc. Mr M. Agromet bulletin for farmers

PORT BLAIR, AUG 3/-/ The Central Island Agricultural Research Institute has released the agromet bulletin for farmers for the period from Aug 4 to 8, 2018. In the bulletin, CIARI forecast cloudy weather with moderate rainfall in the next five days.

In South Andaman 105 mm of rainfall and in North and Middle Andaman 51 mm and in Nicobar Island 136 mm of rainfall is expected during this period. The maximum temperature will be 29 to 31°C with minimum temperature of 24 to 28°C, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 80 to 83% and 76 to 80%, respectively in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Wind speed of 31 to 42 kmph is expected from South Westery direction. Farmers in South Andaman have been advised to do weeding in rice main field and maintain thin film of water, do breeding of IMC carp fishes and store spawn in well managed nursery pond and provide anthelmintic treatment to livestock (cow) with the consultation of veterinary doctors. In Nicobar, farmers have been advised to remove excess water from vegetable field, as good amount of rainfall is expected and provide anthelmintic treatment to livestock (cow) with the consultation of veterinary doctors.
