The Port Blair Regional Centre library has over 100 such CDs on curriculum based lectures and discussion. To facilitate the students of Port Blair, the Regional Centre has started special video classes on Saturdays between 10 am to 1 pm and 3 pm to 5 pm. Special video class on ESO 13 - Journey of a Sociologist, Sociological Theory and Methodology; ESO-14- Status of women in India, Education & Stratification will be organized at first floor of Kannada Sangha Building, IGNOU Regional Centre, Mohanpura on Saturday 13th January 2017. Each topic specific video class will be of 30 minutes duration. It is planned to play 2 to 4 CDs on Saturday. The RC is also informing its learners about the video class through SMS communication. ## Agromet bulletin for farmers

**PORT BLAIR, JAN 12/-** The Central Island Agricultural Research Institute has released the agromet bulletin for farmers for the period from Jan 13-17, 2018. In the bulletin, CIARI forecast partly cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall in the next five days. In South Andaman 68 mm of rainfall, in North and Middle Andaman 9 mm of rainfall and in Nicobar Island 105 mm of rainfall is expected during the period. The maximum temperature will be 30 to 32 degree centigrade with minimum temperature of 24 to 28 degree centigrade, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 70 to 79 % and 62 to 72 %, respectively in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speed of 11 to 26 kmph is expected from North Easterly direction. Farmers in South Andaman have been advised to transplant vegetables like tomato, brinjal and cauliflower in raised beds with drainage facility, prepare the land for sowing of crepe vegetables and incorporate farm yard manure @ 20 to 25 t/ha at the time of last plough, clean the poultry sheds with disinfection solution like Savlon and water and spray lime surrounding area of the poultry farm to avoid disease. In Nicobar, farmers have been advised to provide drainage channel to the vegetable field to avoid stagnation of water as good amount of rainfall is expected and clean the poultry sheds with disinfection solution like savlon and water, spray lime surrounding area of the poultry farm to avoid disease.

## Awareness on TB & DOTS under RNTCP

**PORT BLAIR, JAN 12/-** Under Revised National TB Control Programme, the State TB Control Society Port Blair organized an awareness programme on TB and New Treatment Strategy DOTS and DOTS Plus at Namunagar to create awareness among the general public of the area. A large number of people including ANMs, ANWs, ASHAs attended the programme. Mr. Dilip Kumar (STS) Senior treatment supervisor RNTCP highlighted the basic facts about TB and its prevention measures. Mr. Tapan Kumar Ray, IEC Officer, STBCS spoke in length on TB and New Treatment Strategy DOTS and highlighted the dreadful disease Tuberculosis. Its sign and symptoms, prevention, management and DOTS services available for TB patients at the nearest health centre, free of cost and also discussed



about FDCs (Fixed Dose Combinations) as a daily regimen. MDR TB and HIV co-infection. He urged the gathering to propagate and spread the TB messages to the neighbours and in the community. Cough for more than two weeks may be TB, go to your nearest Health Centre for Sputum Examination. Adopt DOTS for sure cure of TB. He also spoke about the ill effects of Alcohol, smoking and its consequences, particularly in relation to treatment of TB. He appealed to all the participants to give up consumption of Alcohol and smoking. A question answer session was also held in the concluding session, where Mr. Ray and Mr. Kumar replied to all the queries.

## Illicit liquor seized from jungles of Memyo, one held

**PORT BLAIR, JAN 12/-** As part of its efforts to curb the menace of liquor and eradicate illegal trade of illicit liquor and IMFL, the South Andaman Police developed intelligence that some persons are involved in distilling illicit liquor in the jungles of Memyo. On Jan 8 at around 5 am, the police party of PS Humfringunj comprising of SI G.N. Murthy, PC/ 1876 Mintu Kumar Dey, PC/ 175 S.S. Yadav, PC/ 1104 G. Shiva and HG(D)/ 44 Prafulla Dha reached Memyo Jungle and conducted search in the Jungle area and apprehended a person namely V. Subbiah, R/o Memyo

who was involved in distillation of Illicit liquor. One Plastic Jaricane containing Illicit liquor and other Bhatti Articles were recovered. A case vide Crime No.04/2018 dated 08/01/2018 U/s 32 Reg. III of 1876 has been registered at Police Station Humfringunj. The whole operation was conducted under the supervision of Insp. K. Binoj, SHO PS Humfringunj.   - The period of licence/tenure will be for five (05) years from the date of allotment for Municipal Shops and Three (03) years for Food Kiosks and Permanent Stall 'A'. The period of tenancy will not be extended under any circumstances. Thereafter the shop will be re-tendered through transparent, fair and competitive bidding process.
  - The allottee (hereinafter will be called as "Tenant") shall execute an agreement on non-judicial bond paper of Rs.20/- within 07 days from acceptance of the bid.
  - The successful bidder, within 07 (seven) days of the offer letter has to deposit as security deposit as mentioned above to the Council in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt in favour of "Secretary, PBMC" valid for a period of 65 months for Municipal Shops and 42 months for Food Kiosks/Permanent Stall No. 'A' and same will be returned after completion of the licence/tenant period.
  - On completion of first year the monthly rent for Municipal Shops/Food Kiosks/Permanent Stall will be enhanced by 10% of the successful bid amount and rounded off to the next Rs.10/- For example if the successful bid is Rs.100/- per month then the monthly rent would be as follows:-
