**Blood Donation Camp by ANACS at Chatham**

**PORT BLAIR, AUG 28/-** The Andaman & Nicobar AIDS Control Society (ANACS) organised a Voluntary Blood Donation camp at Chatham Dispensary, Mill Division, Chatham here on Tuesday. Altogether, 20 donors (male and female) donated blood during the camp. The VBD camp was conducted under the leadership of Dr. M. Jay Project Director, A & N AIDS Control Society and Director, State Blood Transfusion Council, A & N Islands.

He has advised young people to become donors to ensure voluntary non-remunerated safe blood supply with retention of healthy donors. With this we are aiming to establish availability of 100% voluntary blood donation by 2020 in this island. The blood donation camp was facilitated by the Dr. Ganesh Samadhar, Deputy Director (Blood Safety), ANACS. He emphasised that apart from



being a noble cause, blood donation will also keep a person updated of his physical status. He also examined the donors for their eligibility to donate blood and briefed the donors on various aspect and importance of blood donation.

Dr. R. C. Kar, Chief Medical Officer (NFSG) (Rtd) Consultant, Chatham Dispensary, Mill Division, Chatham, Port Blair coordinated the camp at the Chatham campus. The technical team from Blood Bank, C. B. Pant Hospital, Port Blair and A & N AIDS Control Society ensure that the donated blood units are screened for transmissible diseases. They also examined the donors for eligibility for blood donation and briefed the donors on various aspect and importance of blood donation. Donors certificate were also distributed among the voluntary donors.

**PORT BLAIR, AUG 28/-** The president, Pradesh Congress Committee, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, during his recent visit to Kadamtala, was appraised by villagers about non availability of PGT Chemistry and PGT Commerce in Govt. **VIJAYPUR, AUG 28/-** A large number of heavily armed terrorists are waiting across the Line of Control and the International Border for an opportunity to sneak into the state, Jammu and Kashmir police chief S P Vaid said today. Our BSF and Army personnel, however, are fully alert to the challenge and it is because of their efforts that the terrorists are unable to succeed in their designs, he said.

**CIARI's agromet advisory for farmers**

**PORT BLAIR, AUG 28/-** The Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (CIARI) has predicted that cloudy weather with moderate to heavy rainfall is likely to occur during next five days in the North and Middle Andaman. 142 mm of rainfall is expected during this period in these islands. The maximum temperature in North and Middle Andaman will be 30 degree Celsius with minimum temperature of 25 degree Celsius, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 80 to 83 %, and 76 to 78 % respectively in North and Middle Andaman. Wind speed of 23 to 33 km/h is expected from South Westerly direction. South Andaman is likely to witness cloudy weather with moderate rainfall during next five days. In South Andaman 116 mm of rainfall is expected during this period. The maximum temperature in South Andaman will be 30 degree Celsius with minimum temperature of 25 degree Celsius, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 80 to 81 %, and 77 to 78 % respectively in South Andaman. Wind speed of 25 to 35 km/h is expected from South Westerly direction.

Under these weather conditions, Rice Farmers of the North, Middle and South Andaman have been advised by CIARI to keep the bund of rice main field open at 10 cm height and keep the drainage canal to facilitate draining of water. Vegetable growers of these islands must avoid intercultural operation in the vegetable field as moderate rainfall is expected. Cattle owners may contact local veterinary doctors for vaccination against foot and mouth disease to cow and buffalo. The Nicobar district is likely to witness cloudy weather with moderate rainfall during next five days. 49 mm of rainfall is expected during this period in this district. The maximum temperature will be 30 to 31 degree Celsius with minimum temperature of 24 to 25 degree Celsius, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be 80 to 83 %, and 79 to 80 %, respectively in Nicobar Islands. Wind speed of 23 to 31 km/h is expected from South Westerly direction. Under these weather conditions, CIARI has suggested that Cow, buffalo and goat owners of the Nicobar Islands must provide an helminthic treatment to adult animals (Cow, buffalo and goat) with the consultation of local veterinary doctors. After the treatment, feed them sprouted Bengal gram @ 100 gm/adult cattle and @ 25 gm/adult goat for three days. The bulletin is valid for the period from Aug 29 to Sept 2, 2018. (PIB, Port Blair)
