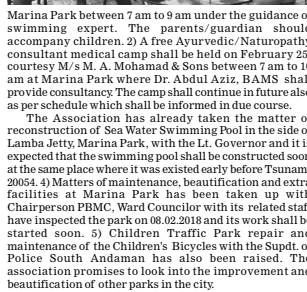

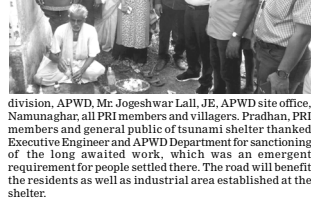

Repair of tsunami shelter

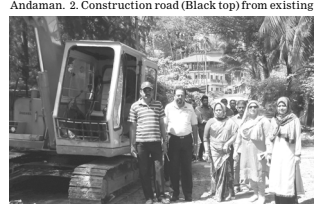
