

Ex-CPM leader sentenced to death, 5 others jailed for life in Kerala Cong leader murder case

KOCHI, APRIL 21 /-/ A former local CPM leader was on Saturday sentenced to death by the additional district sessions court in Kerala's Alappuzha after he was found guilty in a case pertaining to the murder of a Congress worker in 2009. Judge K Anil Kumar, who was hearing the case, also awarded life imprisonment to the other five co-accused in the case. The convict, K R Baiju, had been the CPM local secretary at Changanassery in Alappuzha district. According to the prosecution, the murdered Congress worker K S Divakaran was a coir worker. The incident happened when Baiju along with others on December 9, 2009, went to Divakaran's house to sell a coir product as part of the Left government scheme to promote coir products, billed as "a coir product in a house."

But, Divakaran refused to buy the product, allegedly due to its exorbitant price. The CPM men then dropped the product at Divakaran's doorstep, before leaving his house. The issue later snowballed into a tiff between Divakaran's son Dileep and the CPM leader. The police probe had found that the gang led by the local CPM leader attacked Divakaran's house the same night, as a sequel to the row. Divakaran, who sustained serious injuries, died at a hospital. His son Dileep and daughter-in-law Rashmi too had sustained injuries in the attack. Police brought Baiju before the court as the sixth accused in the murder case. Later, CPI(M) had sacked him from the party.

Youth beaten to death by villagers in a land dispute

BETTIAH, APRIL 21 /-/ A 23-year-old man was beaten to death allegedly by a group of villagers over a land dispute at Thakur Pota in West Champaran district, police said today. About 12 people surrounded Manjit Thakur while he was returning home from Lauriya bazar, near Bhaktahan bridge in the village, and beat him up with iron rods before fleeing from the spot last night, they said. The deceased was professionally a driver and a resident of the same village. Some of the villagers informed the family members about Manjit's critical condition who was referred to the MJK Hospital at Bettiah. Manjit died on way to the hospital. There was a dispute between the family of Thakur and that of the murder case. A piece of land measuring five cotta, they said.

Tigress found dead in UP sanctuary

MAHARAJGANJ, APRIL 21 /-/ A tigress was found dead in the Sohagi Barwa Wildlife Sanctuary here, a forest official said today. The carcass of the tigress was spotted on Friday by some villagers in the Ganespur beat, which comes under the sanctuary's Madhwalaya range, forest range officer Imtiaz Ahmad said. It is not immediately known how the big cat died, he said, adding that the body was sent for post mortem. Officials have been on high alert for the past few days since the recovery of a leopard carcass last month from the Chuak forest range of the sanctuary.

CRPF officer killed in gunfight with Maoists in Sukma

RAIPUR, APRIL 21 /-/ An officer of the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) was killed in a gunfight with the Maoists in a dense forest in the insurgency-hit Sukma district of Chhattisgarh, police said today. The gunfight took place on Friday night in Kistarnam police station area when a team of CRPF's 212th battalion was out on a search-cum-area domination operation. Deputy Inspector General of Police (South Base Range) Sandaraj P Neng agency was killed in the incident, he said. The deceased was a native of Madhya Pradesh. Security forces have launched a combing operation in the area, located around 500 km away from the state capital Raipur, he added.

AIADMK to field candidates from 3 constituencies in Karnataka polls

CHENNAI, APRIL 21 /-/ The ruling AIADMK in Tamil Nadu today announced it would field its candidates from three Assembly constituencies for the May 12 Karnataka polls. AIADMK coordinator O Panneerselvam and co-coordinator K Palanisami announced their party's candidates for Hanur, Gandhinagar and Kolar Gold Field Assembly segments. M P Yuvraj is the party's pick for Gandhinagar while R P Vishnu Kumar and M Anbu will contest from Hanur and Kolar Gold Fields respectively. The two leaders made the announcement in a party statement. Yuvraj was recently appointed Karnataka state unit secretary of the AIADMK. The AIADMK had contested five seats in the 2013 elections. Rivals Congress and BJP are locked in a fierce fight in the May 12 elections to 224 assembly constituencies in Karnataka.

Tourist spots in Valley, Ladakh region declared 'no polythene' zones

SRINAGAR, APRIL 21 /-/ The Jammu and Kashmir government has declared tourist destinations and resorts in the Valley and Ladakh region as polythene-free zones, and banned the use of non-biodegradable plastic at its properties, according to an official order. The government aims to achieve sustainable tourism and make tourist destinations in the state eco-friendly with this step. "In order to make Kashmir division, including Leh and Kargil, polythene-free, it is hereby ordered that all tourist spots and resorts in the Valley and Ladakh region are declared polythene-free zones. The tourist destinations or resorts are also

brought under the ambit of no polythene zones," the order issued by Mehmoos Shah, director of tourism, Kashmir, stated. According to the order, use of polythene and disposable plastic at tourist destinations and properties would lead to cancellation of the operator's licence. "Any deviation shall be dealt strictly. Persistent cancellation shall warrant cancellation of registration certificate issued by the tourism department," it said.

Asked about the order, Shah said all tourist spots and resorts are sustainable tourism and making tourist destinations eco-friendly.

Some Cong MLAs upset with Punjab Cabinet expansion

CHANDIGARH, APRIL 21 /-/ Two more Congress MLAs expressed disappointment today for being ignored in the expansion of the Punjab Cabinet, hours before the scheduled swearing-in of the new ministers.

Narvej Singh Cheema and Gurkirat Singh Kotli voiced their unhappiness a day after another Congress legislator Sangat Singh Gilzian resigned from All India Congress Committee (AICC) and as Punjab Pradesh Congress Committee vice president over the issue. Congress finalised the names of nine new ministers on Friday after meetings, spread over two days, between party chief Rahul Gandhi and Punjab Chief Minister Amarinder Singh in New Delhi. Khanna MLA Gurkirat Singh Kotli, who is the grandson of former Punjab chief

minister Beant Singh, said "old and traditional" families that have won elections for the party should have been considered for Cabinet berths.

"I meet all the criteria for becoming a minister but a junior person has been inducted. I fought three elections and won twice," Cheema said. Cheema, who is from Sultanpur Lodhi in Kapurthala district, said he was disappointed that the Doaba region was "ignored."

"Only one ministerial berth has been given to Doaba (Sunder Sanj Arora) and that too represents the Kandli area. The main Doaba region comprising Jalandhar and Kapurthala, which is known as the NRI belt, is completely ignored," he said. "Whenever Congress won seats from the Doaba region, it formed the

government," he said.

With the induction of Dera Baba Nanak MLA Sukhinder Randhawa in the Cabinet, Gurdaspur district now has three ministers. Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa (Fatehgarh Churian) and Aruna Chaudhary (Dinanagar) already represented the district in the ministry. Amritsar also has three ministers now with the induction of O P Soni (Amritsar Central) and Sukhinder Sarkaria (Raja Sansi).

Navjot Singh Sidhu from Amritsar East was already a minister. Cheema said he could not understand why his name was "dropped at the last moment" and will take up the matter with the chief minister. Meanwhile, Kotli argued in favour of Punjab's "traditional" families.

Man held for raping, killing 4-month-old girl in Indore

INDORE, APRIL 21 /-/ A man has been arrested for allegedly raping and killing a four-month-old baby girl in Indore city of Madhya Pradesh, police said today. A day after the infant's body was found in the basement of a commercial building here. Naveen Gadge, 25 and a cousin of the victim's mother, was arrested last night from the city, a police official said. On Friday, police had detained three-four people in connection with the crime and identified the main suspect as Sunil Bheel, 21. But today, Indore Deputy Inspector General H C Mishra told reporters that the police department has found Gadge as the accused in the case after a thorough investigation. Police has released Bheel after questioning. Detailing the sequence of events, the senior police officer said Gadge's wife separated from him a few days ago.

"On Thursday night, he went to the girl's mother and asked her to persuade his wife to return to him. However, an altercation broke out between them and he was told to leave," Mishra said. Early Friday Gadge returned to the family, who earn their livelihood selling balloons, when they were sleeping under an open space near the historic Rajwada Palace and abducted the girl, the DIG said.

Substandard material used in school construction in Poonch, probe ordered

JAMMU, APRIL 21 /-/ Taking serious note of a complaint alleging use of substandard material in the construction of a school building near the LOC, authorities in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch district have ordered an inquiry into the matter, a senior official said today.

Over 300 students belonging to villages along the Line of Control (LoC) in the Mendhar sector are enrolled with the Dharana High School. The school was upgraded from a middle school in 2011 at a cost of Rs 58 lakh under the Centrally sponsored Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) scheme by the roads and buildings department. The inquiry was ordered after the school administration intimated that the contractor had used substandard material for the construction of a building in the school, rendering it unsafe for putting into use for the students, the official said. Taking cognisance of the complaint, district development commissioner, Poonch, Mohammad Ajaz Asad ordered the inquiry and constituted a four-member committee, he said.

The committee, which will be headed by the additional district development commissioner of Poonch, has been directed to submit its report within one week. Quoting from the complaint, the official said it was alleged that substandard material was used in the construction of the school building, which is prone to shelling from across the LoC. Only six rooms have been constructed instead of sanctioned eight rooms. The constructed rooms are also without doors and windows making these not worthy of use for students, according to the complaint.

Punjab Police caution people against fake message on WhatsApp

CHANDIGARH, APRIL 21 /-/ The Punjab Police has cautioned the people against a "fake" message being circulated on a mobile application, along with the picture of the Director General of Police (DGP), asking women to call up at a mobile number if they needed help. "Dear citizens, a WhatsApp message is being circulated with the pic of DGP PB asking ladies to call a particular no in case of need upon which their vehicle will be tracked. If it's a fake message so don't circulate it," the Punjab Police said in a tweet.
