## Kejriwal's kin moves court for transfer of plea against him

NEW DELHI, FEB 27 --- A Delhi court today issued notice on a plea by Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's brother-in-law seeking transfer of a criminal complaint filed against him and the AAP chief in the alleged PWD scam to another court. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Satish Kumar Arora sought the response of the founder of the Roads Anti-Corruption Organisation (RACO), who filed the complaint against Kejriwal and his relative Surender Kumar Bansal.

The court also summoned the The court also summoned the case record from the court of Metropolitan Magistrate Abhilash Malhotra, before whom the matter is pending, and listed the transfer application of Bansal for further hearing on March 16. The B-JYM distributed a phone number among the students and asked them to give a missed call on it if they felt 'betrayed' by the Arvind Kejrival government. There is widespread resentment among youth against Arvind Kejrival for not fulfilling the electoral promises like free WiFi, setting up 20 new colleges and 500 new schools, installing 16 lakh CCTV cameras and deployment of marshals in buses. The youth today feels betrayed. Delhi BJYM president Sunil Yadav claimed. A dedicated mobile number is being given to the people especially youth so that they can lodge their protest against the 'non fulfillment' of electoral promises by AAP government, he said. Gearing up for the MCD polls, scheduled to be held in April, BJP and its various wings have launched a focused attack on AAP government, charging if of not fulfilling promises made by it before coming to power in Delhi.
