## Number of people filing I-T returns rises 50% to 6.08cr, says CBDT chief

NEW DELHI, DEC 4 /--/ The number of people filing Income Tax returns has increased 50 per cent to 6.08 crore so far in the assessment year 2018-19 compared to the year-ago period, a top official said

Tuesday.

Chairman Sushil Chandra also exuded
confidence that the Revenue Department
would achieve direct tax collection target
from the control of t esday. Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT)

b illicit fund flows. "Our gross direct tax growth rate is 16.5 cent and net direct tax growth rate is 5 per cent, which itself shows that demonetisation really helped in widening and deepening of tax base. "As on date, total direct tax mop up stood at 48 per cent

of the Budget estimate (BE)," the CBDT chief said.

He also said the number corporate tax payers have gone up to 8 lakh as a result of demonetisation. Speaking at an event organised by industry body CII, Chandra said the CBDT has so far given 2.27 corve

said the CBDT has so far given 2.2r core refunds during the 2018-19 assessment year, which is 50 per cent higher than the last four years, India's tax base has gone up by 80 per cent, he added. Noting that the government was committed to reduce corporate tax rate, he said, 'our tax compliance should be good so that the government is in a position to reduce the (corporate) tax rate.' The CBDT, the apex policy making body for direct taxes, plans to provide e-PAN (Permanent Account Number) within four hours of receiving an application. We are putting a new system in place.
