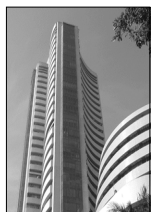


Sensex logs 1st fall in seven days; pharma, financials play spoilsport

MUMBAI, DEC 4 /-/- Market benchmark Sensex ended lower by 106.69 points, or 0.29 per cent, to close at 36,134.31. Similarly, the broader NSE Nifty edged up by 14.25 points, or 0.12 per cent, to end at 10,885.50. Pharma major Sun Pharma remained the worst loser in the Sensex pack for the second day in a row. Rupee gave up some gains while the fall in India's 10 year bond yield to 7.5 is giving a sign of dovish policy from the RBI, they added. Investor sentiment was also cautious on weak cues from global markets after the euphoria over US-China trade deal settled and uncertainty over negotiations between the two countries resurfaced. Banking, FMCG and auto stocks were the biggest losers on Sensex and Nifty. Sun Pharma, M&M, HDFC, SBI, NTPC, IndusInd Bank, HDFC Bank, HUL, Yes Bank, Asian Paints and Axis Bank fell up to 3 per cent. While, ONGC, Infosys, Wipro, Vedanta, TCS, Coal India, Bajaj Auto, Power Grid, Bharati Airtel, and Tata Steel were the top gainers, rising up to 2.52 per cent. (PTI)

Rupee slips further 3 paise to 70.49 against \$

MUMBAI, DEC 4 /-/- The rupee slipped further by paise to close at 70.49 against the US dollar Tuesday due to increased demand for the American currency from importers and firming global crude oil prices. Forex traders said the dollar strengthening against major global currencies overtook any losses in the domestic equity market also weighed on the local unit. At the Interbank Foreign Exchange (forex) market, the rupee opened lower at 70.50 and fell further to touch the day's low of 70.68 a dollar. The domestic currency, however, pared some losses and finally ended at 70.49 per dollar, down by 3 paise against its previous close. On Monday, the rupee had dropped by 88 paise, its biggest single-day loss in more than three months, to close at 70.66 against the US currency. The rupee came under pressure following heavy selling in domestic equities and rise in crude oil prices. Brent crude, the international benchmark, again was quoted at USD 63.09 per barrel Tuesday, higher by 2.27 per cent, putting pressure on the local unit.

Number of people filing I-T returns rises 50% to 6.08cr, says CBDT chief

NEW DELHI, DEC 4 /-/- The number of people filing Income Tax returns has increased by 50 per cent so far in the assessment year 2018-19 compared to the year ago period, a top official said Tuesday.

Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) Chairman Sushil Chandra also exuded confidence that the Revenue Department would achieve direct tax collection target of Rs 11.5 lakh crore for the current financial year ending March 31, 2019. "Demotisation has been very good for this particular date. So this is the effect of demotisation," he said.

However, he did not mention the exact date when the filings touched 6.08 crore. In November 2018, the government cancelled old Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes as legal tenders as part of larger efforts to curb illicit fund flows. "Our gross direct tax growth rate is 16.5 per cent and net direct tax growth rate is 14.5 per cent, which itself shows that demotisation really helped in widening and deepening of tax base." As on date, total direct tax mop up stood at 48 per cent of the Budget estimate (BE), the CBDT chief said.
