

Sensex, Nifty regain footing on macro cheers, Turkish lira rebound

MUMBAI, AUGUST 14 /-- Benchmark 30-stock Sensex and Nifty Tuesday regained confidence after two sessions of loss on emergence of buying mainly in financial, healthcare and IT stocks as market participants cheered moderate July inflation numbers and some recovery in Turkish Lira assuaged jittery investors globally. The 30-crip Sensex rose over 207 points to close at 37,852 and the broader NSE Nifty rallied above the 11,400 mark.

In contrast to equities, the Indian rupee today crashed below the historic 70 level for the first time and plummeted to the day's low of 70.09, tracking developments in global markets.

However, global equity markets seemed regaining confidence as the threat from the Turkish Lira crisis ebbed. The Turkish currency rebounded from its record low in early trade, strengthening against the US dollar after Turkey's central bank intervention. Also, domestic market sentiment was buoyed by July inflation numbers. Wholesale inflation eased to 5.09 per cent in July on account of cheaper food articles from 5.77 per cent in June. Retail inflation also fell to a nine-month low of 4.17 in July.

Unabated buying by domestic institutional investors (DIIs) and robust corporate Q1 earnings by some blue-chip firms too drew investors sentiment. Mixed trend on Asian bourses and higher opening in European markets also supported the upmove on domestic bourses.

"Markets reversed yesterday's loss led by broad-based buying across sectors as investors rejoiced the moderation in domestic CPI and WPI inflation despite INR hitting historic low of Rs70 against USD. Pharma & IT sectors outperformed the key indices on account of INR depreciation."

Sebi panel suggests confidentiality clause in settlement mechanism

NEW DELHI, AUGUST 14 /-- A high-level Sebi panel has proposed a confidentiality clause in the settlement mechanism, wherein identity of the applicant will not be disclosed, in order to garner information of defaults as well as possible violations from defaulters in the settlements.

Currently, the settlement regulation does not have a provision for settlement with confidentiality and all settlement orders contain details of the applicant and are published on Sebi website.

"There is no explicit provision for an applicant to voluntarily provide information to the (Sebi) board relating to the fraudulent and unfair trade practices and other serious defaults that would assist the board in dealing with any inquiry, investigation, inspection, and audit," the panel said in its report submitted to the regulator.

The panel headed by retired judge A R Dave has suggested for a provision for settlement with confidentiality clause in the settlement mechanism. It has recommended that even the settlement order in case of settlement by the committee will not be published. However, the identity of the applicant may not be disclosed.

The settlement mechanism enables entities to settle charges against them without admission or denial of guilt on payment of a sum.

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) has sought comments from public till September 1 on the committee's suggestions and final regulation will be put in place after taking into view of the stakeholders.

It also suggested not settling the case with willful defaulters and fugitive economic offenders under settlement norms.

Sundaram BNP Paribas Housing Finance to raise Rs 3,500 cr

CHENNAI, AUGUST 14 /-- City-based Sundaram BNP Paribas Home Finance Ltd is planning to raise Rs 3,500 crore during this financial year to fund its expansion plans, managing director of the company Srinivas Acharya said.

The company is a joint venture between non-banking finance firm Sundaram Finance Ltd and BNP Paribas Personal Finance. The company would continue to focus on the southern States and increase penetration into its existing areas of operations, Acharya said. "To fund our expansion, we plan to raise Rs 3,500 crore this year through a mix of term loans from banks, refinance from National Housing Bank, subordinated debt, fixed deposits and commercial papers", he said in a statement here. The company currently has over 110 branches across the country serving 50,000 customers. "Rating agency ICRA has upgraded our fixed deposit rating to AAAA (stable) from AAA+, the company said. "The outlook on the long-term rating is reaffirmed at AA+ stable", it said.
