

Haldia Power Plant wins ICC Environment Excellence Award

KOLKATA, DEC 21 /-- The 600 mw Haldia Energy Power Plant Ltd (HEL) is this year's winner of the prestigious ICC Environment Excellence Award. At the Environment Partnership Summit in Kolkata on Wednesday, the award was presented to HEL managing director Mr. Rabi Choudhury. The Runners Ups in the category were ITC Limited, Mungar Plant (India Tobacco Division). This is the 11th year of the ICC Award programme, the initiative being supported by the department of environment, government of West Bengal and West Bengal Pollution Control Board. Companies in the Large Business Organisation Segment applied from all over the country. After the initial selection process,

HEL was selected for a presentation in front of the Jury. Thereafter, it was subjected to onsite assignment as part of the final selection criteria. While deciding on the award, the judges examined the environment management practices, the focus areas being pollution control, green initiatives, and environmental performance trends, as also future plans for improvements. This was followed by a site visit to examine the company's commitment towards environment, health and safety. The judges particularly appreciated HEL's air pollution control measures and its innovative approach for restricting chimney emission, green belt development, conversion of existing office buildings in green buildings and comprehensive waste management schemes.

The HEL plant, inaugurated by Mamata Banerjee, chief minister, government of West Bengal, began commercial generation (300 mw) on January 28, 2015, the second unit (300 mw) was commissioned on February 21, 2015. (EOIC)

68.5 % votes cast in Arunachal by-poll

ITANAGAR, DEC 21 /-- An estimated 68.5 per cent votes were cast in today's by-poll for Pakke-Kessang and Likabali constituencies in Arunachal Pradesh, polling for which was held today. Pakke-Kessang recorded 86 per cent polling, while Likabali constituency recorded 51 per cent, joint chief electoral officer D J Bhattacharjee informed.

Two state-of-the-art escalators commissioned at Shyambazar Metro

KOLKATA, DEC 21 /-- Metro Railway, Kolkata has undertaken a lot of initiatives with a view to provide more amenities to its commuters. As part of its programme, two state-of-the-art escalators have been commissioned at Shyambazar Metro station.

The escalators were inaugurated by two senior officials on Thursday. The two escalators have been installed parallel to each other for upward and downward movement of the passengers between mezzanine and surface gate at the South side of Shyambazar station which have replaced the 22 year old escalators.

These escalators are provided with energy efficient features and human sensors for automatic stopping when there are no passengers. These also have latest safety features prescribed by Research Designs and Standards Organisation (RDSO). 16 old escalators have been identified for replacement and the scheme is under finalisation.

The existing escalators will be replaced by latest modification of the existing civil structure and provision of latest safety feature for passenger safety. It is targeted to complete the replacement work within next two years. (EOIC)

Technical snag developed in one EVM at Durpaipolling station under Likabali due to which polling was suspended, he said adding re-polling would be ordered in both the booths.

Though polling was moderate during the morning hours due to chilly weather conditions, it gained momentum as the day progressed. Elaborate security arrangements were made with state police, ITBP and four companies of central paramilitary forces being deployed. The critical polling booths were covered by CRPF and IRB personnel. Altogether 150 polling personnel were deployed for Pakke-Kessang, while 220 polling personnel conducted the polling in Likabali, Bhattacharjee said.

The Pakke-Kessang Assembly seat has 7,455 voters including 3943 women, while Likabali has 10688 electors including 5331 women voters.

Former deputy chief minister Kameng Dolo (Congress) is contesting against BJP nominee P R Waghe in Pakke-Kessang, while the Likabali constituency witnessed a multi-cornered contest by Karido Nyigvor (BJP), Modam Dini (Congress), Gumke Riba of Peoples Party of Arunachal and independent candidate Senjo Taipodia.

FIR filed against fake resignation letter of Nagaland CM

KOIHMA, DEC 21 /-- The Nagaland Chief Minister's Office (CMO) has filed an FIR against the circulation of a fake and forged resignation letter of chief minister T R Zeliang and his Cabinet colleagues on social media. The first information report (FIR) was lodged at the Kohima Police station on Wednesday by the Officer on Special Duty (OSD) to the chief minister, police said.

It stated a fake and forged letter of the chief minister is being circulated on social media. The letter head of the chief minister of Nagaland has been forged as also a fake letter number has been given, the FIR stated, adding that the signature of the chief minister has been forged. The FIR stated that the forgery was very serious and amounts to cyber crime as also spreading rumors with an objective to create confusion and unrest in society. Kohima Police said it has registered a case in this connection and investigation is in progress. (PTT)

ER's ticket checking drive

State SC Advisory Council holds first meeting

KOLKATA, DEC 21 /-- The Scheduled Caste Advisory Council of West Bengal held its first meeting here today under West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee and decided to meet every six months, officials said. Besides Banerjee, chief secretary Malay Dey, West Bengal Backward classes welfare minister Churamani Mahata was among those present at the meeting. The state Cabinet had decided in October to set up the council to look into the development of people belonging to the scheduled castes in the state. The council will look into the development of the social, educational, economical and cultural matters of the scheduled castes in the state and function on the lines of the existing tribal advisory council, the officials said. Out of the total 295 assembly seats in Bengal there are 66 reserved for scheduled caste candidates. (PTT)

Action against Bihar sand mafias demanded

NEW DELHI, DEC 21 /-- Expelled RJD MP Yadav today sought the Centre's intervention in ensuring action against the alleged sand mafia in Bihar. Raising the issue in Lok Sabha during the Zero Hour, he said appropriate action should be initiated immediately against the sand mafia in the state and labourers working there should be tasked to run the sand quarries. The Centre must intervene in removing the sand mafia. It is a major issue confronting the state and I demand immediate action against those involved in illegal activities," Yadav said. He said thousands of daily wage workers were rendered jobless in the last few months due to arbitrary action of the sand mafia. Earlier this month, Bihar's main Opposition party RJD had blamed the faulty sand mining policy of the state government for the crisis of sand and rendering thousands of labourers jobless. (PTT)

State student council polls in April-June: Partha

KOLKATA, DEC 21 /-- The West Bengal government will conduct student council elections in colleges during April-June, even if terms of present elected student bodies in different colleges and universities expire by January 31.

The student council elections cannot be held before the end of Higher Secondary Examinations (HS) on April 11, state education minister Partha Chatterjee told reporters on Wednesday night. "It is not binding on us to wrap up the students council election schedule by December 1-January 31. The elections can always be held a bit later to ensure the Higher Secondary Examination schedule is not hampered," Chatterjee said. The HS Examination would be held from March 27 to April 11 and the Joint Entrance Examination on April 22. The JE is conducted in different college buildings, while the HS Examination is held in both school and college buildings.

Elections to student councils in different colleges across Bengal were scheduled during December 2017-January 2018. To another question, Chatterjee said the government has decided that all state-run primary and secondary schools, and college buildings would get a fresh coat of paint.

"Our institutions should not have a worn-out look, but be visually appealing and well-maintained throughout the year," he said. (PTT)

Two boys crushed to death on NH-5

BALASORE, DEC 21 /-- Two boys were crushed to death on National Highway-5 at Suthang under Khandapada police station today when a speeding truck run over them. The victims were identified as Amulya Dash (19) and Rakesh Dash (20), workers at a gas distribution agency here. The truck crushed them when they were standing by the roadside, police said. Both of them died on the spot. The truck is yet to be traced. (PTT)
