

Nifty tops 10k for a moment, Sensex slips from record

MUMBAI, JULY 25 /-/- The historic 10,000 level proved to be short-lived Tuesday as the Nifty closed with a negative bias and the Sensex lost from its life high after investors went for profit in recent gains.

The NSE benchmark made history breaching the 10,000 level for the first time by hitting an all-time high of 10,011.30 at the outset, led by stronger-than-expected earnings by blue-chips and continuous buying by foreign funds and domestic institutions. But a wave of profit-taking dragged the gauge down by 185.45 points or 0.02 per cent, to settle at 9,964.55. Steady smooth progress and month GST take-off had helped the key indices scale historic highs, traders said. The flagship Sensex climbed to a fresh life high of 32,374.30

before closing down 17.60 points, or 0.05 per cent, at 32,228.71. In the last two trading sessions, the key barometer had gained 341.47 points. "Market made a historical day by touching 10k supported by better earnings from blue-chips and strong liquidity. However, profit booking at higher levels pulled the market to mild correction due to psychological effect, muted Q1 results for corporates and awaiting Fed monetary policy meet," said Vinod Nair, Head of Research, Geojit Financial Services. PTI also looked up to US Federal Reserve policy meeting later today. Key indices in the Asian region fell. Major losers include Lupin 1.96 per cent, along with Tata Motors, Coal India and Sun Pharma. Asian Points

fell 0.35 per cent after the company today reported 20.23 per cent decline in consolidated net profit for the first quarter ended June. Bharti Airtel surged 1.76 per cent after reports of the government considering giving telecom companies more time to pay for the spectrum they bought, in a bid to ease sector stress. Axis Bank too rose 1.94 per cent. TCS up 1.50 per cent and Tata Steel 1.06 per cent. Domestic institutional investors (DIIs) bought shares worth Rs 668.87 crore while foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) sold to the tune of Rs 366.84 crore yesterday. A showed provisional data. The Nikkei 225 index fell the most. Auto, healthcare and FMCG too weighed. Sectoral indices such as metal, realty and banking finished higher.

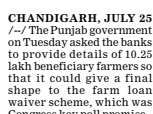

Debt waiver: Punjab govt seeks details of farmers from banks



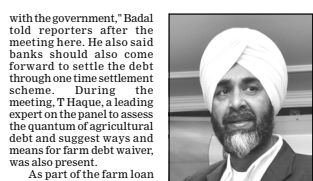
CHANDIGARH, JULY 25 /-/- The Punjab government on Tuesday asked the banks to provide details of 10.25 lakh beneficiary farmers so that it could give a final shape to the farm loan waiver scheme, which was Congress key poll promise.

Under pressure to bring the scheme at the earliest, state Finance minister Manpreet Singh Badal Tuesday held a meeting with government-appointed expert panel and the representatives of public sector banks and sought their suggestions. The state government had announced to waive crop loan of up to Rs 2 lakh and sought detail of farmers including small and marginal farmers owning land up to five acres from banks. The

government has also asked banks to commence this exercise on campaign mode in coordination with district administration to cut any delay.

"We today held discussions with banks and asked them to provide us details of 10 lakh beneficiary farmers. We want to know how many of them are small and marginal. We wish these modalities be worked out and in one month time, this scheme be implemented. We told banks to provide us the personal data pertaining to farmers. Since it is not allowed to share personal data by banks, a consent form will be filled up by farmers, as suggested by banks, with the data collected will be shared with the government," Badal told reporters after the meeting here. He also said banks should also come forward to settle the debt through one-time settlement scheme. During the meeting, T Haque, a leading expert on the panel to assess the quantum of agricultural debt and suggest ways and means for farm debt waiver, was also present.

As part of the farm loan waiver scheme, the Punjab government had last month announced to waive off crop loans up to Rs 2 lakh for small and marginal farmers (owning up to 5 acres of land), and a flat Rs 2 lakh relief for all other marginal farmers, irrespective of their loan amount, which would benefit a total of 10.25 lakh farmers, including 8.75



lakh farmers having up to 5 acres of land. "Banks have agreed to share information about farmers with the government if farmer fills land, and a flat Rs 2 lakh relief for all other marginal farmers, irrespective of their loan amount, which would benefit a total of 10.25 lakh farmers, including 8.75

Banks will also share Aadhaar number of farmers with the state government," he further said. (PTI)
